



#### STEP 1






- a press the PRESS button by thumb;
- b pull the plastic strap out of the attachment housing.






- c attach the plastic strap around the rear leg tube;
- d press the PRESS button and insert the plastic strap into the socket of the attachment housing.






- e press the PRESS button and pull the plastic strap to the end;
- f tighten the nut until the whole attachment is fixed tightly against the rear leg tube.

#### STEP 2




- a press the button;
- b insert the PIN of wheel swivel assembly in to the hole. Make sure it is locked by the latch properly.




Assemble the Board supporting arm LHS into the socket of the board;

\* Repeat the same action for RHS.


#### STEP 4



- a press the button by thumb to adjust the angle of the supporting bar;
- b press the button and move the housing up /down to adjust the length. Make sure the board is behind the brakes and wheels.




c – pull the latch by thumb backwards and fit the protrusion bar into the socket of bracket; d – make sure the protrusion bar is latched properly.



e- adjust the width of the supporting arm to fit with the width of the chassis; NOTE: make sure board is parallel with the ground. If not, please repeat action a & b. f- tighten the nut underneath the board, make sure the extending bar is locked properly.


#### STEP 5



a – insert the plastic clip of the storage strap into the slot of board;

b – Now you can raise and stow the board by securing the strap to the chassis of the stroller.

#### STEP 6



a – REMOVING the product: pull the latch by thumb backwards and remove the whole Buggy board assembly;

b – The board attachment assembly LHS and RHS can be left on the chassis.

## CARE AND MAINTANCE

FOR CLEANING USE ONLY A MILD DETERGENT AND WARM WATER DO NOT USE ANY ABBASIVE SUBSTANCES DO NOT EXPOSE TO HEAT REGULARLY CHECK THE BOARD FITTINGS FOR A WEAR AND TEAR OR ANY BROKEN PARTS FROM TIME TO TIME LUBRICATE THE WHEEL AXELS AND THE SWIVEL AXEL WITH WD40 OR ANOTHER LIGHT OIL LUBRICANT AND CLEAN WITH MILD WATER TO PREVENT DUST AND DIRT FROM GATHERING
