



UPHOLSTERY

Our selection of textiles are derived from natural and sustainable fibers that provide an earthen feel. Our high quality fabrics are handwoven and dyed using non-toxic materials.

Variations in color may vary slightly from sample swatches to finished product as a natural occurrence due to the nature of non-toxic dyes. These variations are considered normal; we like to think this adds character and enhances the unique quality of each upholstered

Made by Shoppe piece. Please note we are not able to guarantee an exact color match to swatch samples.

To preserve the longevity of your Made By Shoppe pieces we recommend professional dry cleaning or spot treatment only. Machine washing is not recommended and may compromise the look and feel of upholstery over time.

For additional protection, consider applying a scotch guard to your upholstery. While we do not treat our fabrics in-house, we will happily facilitate additional treatment to protect from spills or stains with a third-party partner. We recommend testing any protectant on a fabric swatch first to ensure satisfaction as the treatment may alter the look and feel of the fabric.

For velvet fabrics please do not allow for heavy/sharp edges to rest upon or lean against the fabrics in order to avoid permanent marks. To clean up stains, we recommend blotting the stain with a clean, dry cloth to remove excess stain residue. Use a mild dishwashing detergent with water and apply only the suds onto the stain and blot again with a dry cloth. Then let it dry.

WOOD

Each Made by Shoppe wood piece is crafted and finished by hand. Due to the unique nature of reclaimed wood, no two wood planks are the same. Patina, age, and variation in color is to be expected with our Made by Shoppe wood pieces. Natural variations in the finish may vary from sample to final product and are considered normal, adding to the unique characteristics of handmade furniture. Materials are kiln-dried, however, continued drying over time is common with thick-cut wood. You may notice slight cracking in the wood over time, especially in climates where temperature and moisture in the air change significantly with each season.

After typical daily use, wipe down surfaces with a lightly dampened cloth, following the grain of the wood. Immediately dry any residual moisture with a dry cloth. Avoid letting any liquid sit for an extended period of time to prevent stains or rings. Household cleaners should not be used on our wood tables, only water and a lint-free cloth.

Waxed finishes, specifically those in darker colors, may rub off in small amounts. To revive the finish and natural luster of the wood after daily use, we recommend applying a fresh coat of wax once or twice a year. Simply apply the wax with a lint-free cloth and remove excess.
