23 - Body/Seats, First Row/SEAT, Front/Removal and Installation

REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Before proceeding with the following repair procedure, review all warnings and cautions (Refer to 23 Body/Seats Warning).
- 2. Disconnect and isolate the negative battery cable. If equipped with an Intelligent Battery Sensor (IBS), disconnect the IBS connector first before disconnecting the negative battery cable.
- 3. Position the seat in the full forward position, and remove the rear seat bolts.
- 4. Move the seat to the full rearward position, and remove the front seat bolts.
- 5. Tilt the seat up and disconnect the wire harness connectors, then remove the seat.
- 1. Position the front seat into the vehicle and connect the wire harness connectors.
- 2. Install all the seat bolts and tighten to the proper (Torque Specifications).
- 3. Connect the negative battery cable. If equipped with an Intelligent Battery Sensor (IBS), connect the IBS connector.
- 4. The supplemental restraint system verification test procedure should be performed following service of any supplemental restraint system component (Refer to 28 DTC-Based Diagnostics/CONTROLLER, Occupant Restraint (ORC) Standard Procedure).
