











Cut and fold 25 pieces of Cori beams to the dimensions shown in the table to the right.


To optimize usage, you will want to start with the longest beams first and work your way towards the smaller beams using the leftover pieces along the way.


















12 Take the Jeepney roof that was cut out in step 2.














Add a 2 inch beam for a step at the rear of the Jeepney.


























Push each wheel assembly in place. It may help to rotate wheels slightly as they snap into the brackets.







25 Add the grill guard (optional).






Add the headlights by gluing them onto the side of the grill (optional).
