3 Monogrammed fold-over notecards What can we say? Thank you. Thank you. Thank you. Elegant simplicity!

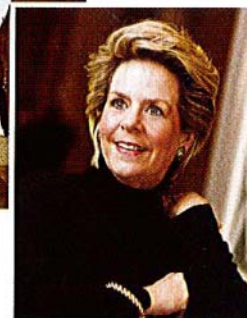


4 House stationery If you love your house, why not celebrate it in print?

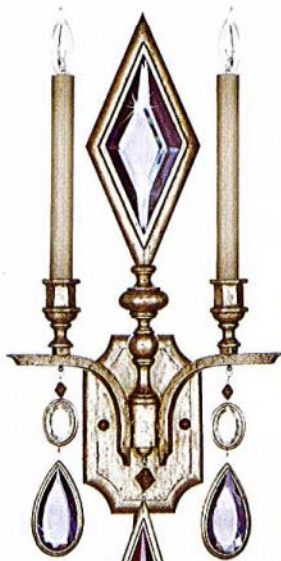


Bunny Williams the buzz on a new line of furnishings
