

KITTY CAT






Materials:


Paper Greylead Oil Pastels Watercolour paints








Divide your page into four using a pencil and a ruler. These are guidelines to help you draw your cat.




Use a pencil first to draw/ sketch the outline, then follow with a marker/pastel and paint.


Draw a big oval/circle at the top of the page for the head, either more towards the left or right side of the page.




To add the first leg, draw a slightly slanted line down from one the side of the head, leaving space at the bottom for the paw.




Draw a shorter line next to the first, starting halfway down. This completes the first leg and connects it to the cat's torso.




Add the second leg.




Add curved shapes for paws at the bottom of the legs. Then add a big curve for the body of the cat. Curve this line around to create a back paw at the bottom.




Complete the outline of the cat's body with lines that connect between the paws. Then add some triangular shaped ears.




Add a triangle to the bottom half of the face to create the mouth area and add a tiny triangle inside it for the nose.



Add the mouth, eyes and toes.



Add in a tail with a loooong curved line.



Add some extra details: whiskers, a bowtie or collar, and maybe some patterns on the fur.



Now add some shapes or patterns in the background and colour your cat in using pastels and paint.
