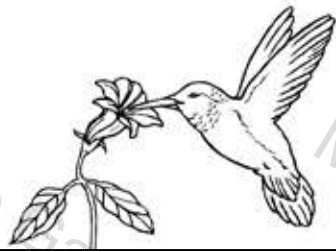

- 1 hummingbird feeder
- 1 brush (to clean the feeding hole)
- 1 S hook, 1 hemp rope (to hang the bird feeder)

How to Use the Feeder

01
Clean the glass bottle and fill it with nectar



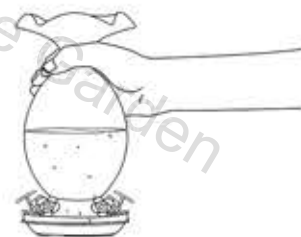
02
Screw the base onto the upside down glass bottle

How to Use the Feeder

03
Flip the entire hummingbird feeder back into the upright position



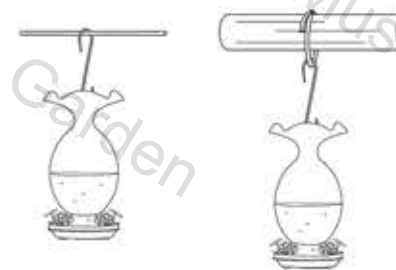
04
Fill the top ant moat with water or vegetable oil, to stop the ants getting into the feeder

How to Use the Feeder

05
Use the S-hook/hemp rope to hang the feeder in the shade outdoors



Cleaning and Maintenance

01
Clean the feeder and wipe off the water on the metal cover. Use a brush to clean the feeding ports.

02
The glass bottle is dishwasher safe. Do NOT clean the bottle and feeder with hot water.

03
Do NOT add cold refrigerated liquid to a hot glass, cool the glass down first.

Nectar Changing Guide

71-75°F	21-23°C	6 days
76-80°F	24-26°C	5 days
81-84°F	27-29°C	4 days
85-88°F	30-31°C	3 days
89-92°F	32-33°C	2 days
93+°F	34+°C	DAILY

* If you notice any mold or fermentation, change the nectar more frequently.

Hummingbird Nectar Recipe

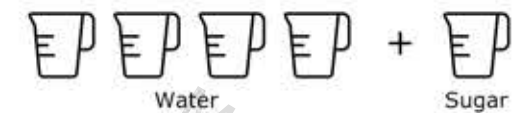
01 Mix 1 part refined white sugar with 4 parts water (for example, 1 cup of sugar with 4 cups of water) until the sugar is dissolved

*Please do not use honey, hot water, corn syrup or raw unprocessed sugars

*Please do not add red dye

02 Fill your hummingbird feeders with the nectar and place outside

*Extra nectar can be stored in a refrigerator
