SIMPLE EAR INTRODUCTION

INSERTING AND REMOVING YOUR LUNATE

Before insertion, always clean your ear and make sure the battery has power. See Palm test, page 1

INSERTION

Place *The Lunate* in the ear using your thumb and forefinger. Make sure the volume button and battery door are pointed away from ear. Insert the sound outlet end into the ear first (Fig D). Then put into the top part of the ear making sure top of the unit secures into fold (Fig E).

REMOVAL

1. To remove **The Lunate**, pull down on earlobe with the thumb and forefinger, push back of ear with thumb creating space for you to grab unit (Fig F).

2. With your other hand grab *The Lunate* with your forefinger at the top of the unit and the bottom with your thumb. Pull straight out of ear.

VOLUME BUTTON: After placing the unit in your ear, press button to select volume level that best fits your listening environment.

1 Beep Low Volume **2 Beeps** Mid Volume

- **3 Beeps** Mid-High Volume
- 4 Beeps Max Volume

Unit defaults to program 1 when restarted.







New Features

Please note that the **Tap Feature** volume control works by air pressure. A slight "seal "created by holding your four fingers together is needed while tapping twice in succession over the unit. The volume can also be changed by simply pushing the button on the battery door. A beep will indicate a change in volume.

CHANGING SOFT TIPS & CLEANING



SOFT TIP ATTACHMENTS

• 1. Soft tips are optional. Please try The Lunate with and without Soft tips. Soft tips simply push on and pull off the end with the Sound outlet (Fig G).



2. Clean soft tips with warm soapy water (Fig H). (Before reapplying soft tip you must make sure it is completely dry.)*Moisture will damage the unit.

3. Use the cleaning tool brush and wax pick at the bottom of its handle to remove any accumulated wax or debris from around the soft tip or sound outlet (Fig I).



• Use a soft cloth to wipe the unit after every use to remove any particles or moisture. Soft tips are designed to be reusable though it is suggested to replace every 3 months.

PROPERLY FITTING YOUR LUNATE



If Sound outlet is centered you will not experience feedback.

FEEDBACK OR WHISTLING

• Feedbak occurs from improper fit. Please make sure the Lunate is properly seated in the ear and the sound outlet is centered in the opening/entrance of the ear canal. The optional soft tips help align the sound outlet in the center of the ear canal opening.

- Wax build up in the ear can also cause feedback. Please flush your ears properly.
- Feedback will also occur if the sound outlet opening or the opening on the end of the soft tip are plugged with wax.

NO SOUND COMING FROM THE UNIT

- Make sure the unit responds to Palm testing. *See page 1
- Make sure battery has power. If not replace it.
- Visually inspect that the soft tip and sound outlet on the unit are clean. Use your cleaning tool if needed.

MAINTENANCE

- Remove soft tip from unit prior to cleaning.
- Clean your soft tips daily with warm soapy water and a small cloth.
- Moisture of ANY KIND will damage the complex circuitry of the unit.
- Do not use any cleaning fluids of any kind.
- Do not go to bed with unit in your ear.
- Turn unit off by opening battery door when not in use to save power.
- Do not use any Electrical appliance to dry or clean.
- Be sure to keep your unit away from any kind of excessive heat.
