

KAT spacebar fix guide

If your spacebar from a KAT set is suffering from slow returns, following these steps will aid in changing the spacebar stems just enough to allow proper return speeds. What you will need

1. Stabilizer with a switch installed
2. The KAT spacebar you wish to fix
3. A size #1 or #2 phillips screwdriver
 - a. #1 is ideal, however #2 does work with extra care taken



1. Insert the screwdriver into the stem of the spacebar gently



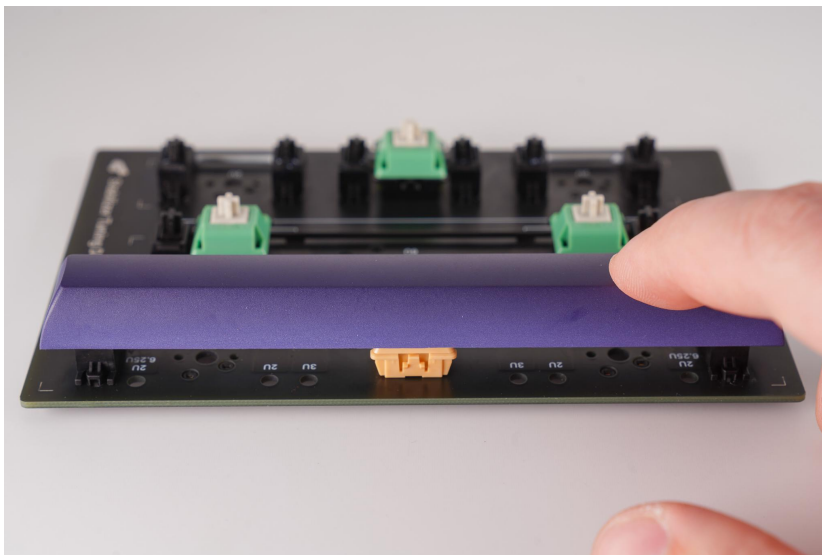
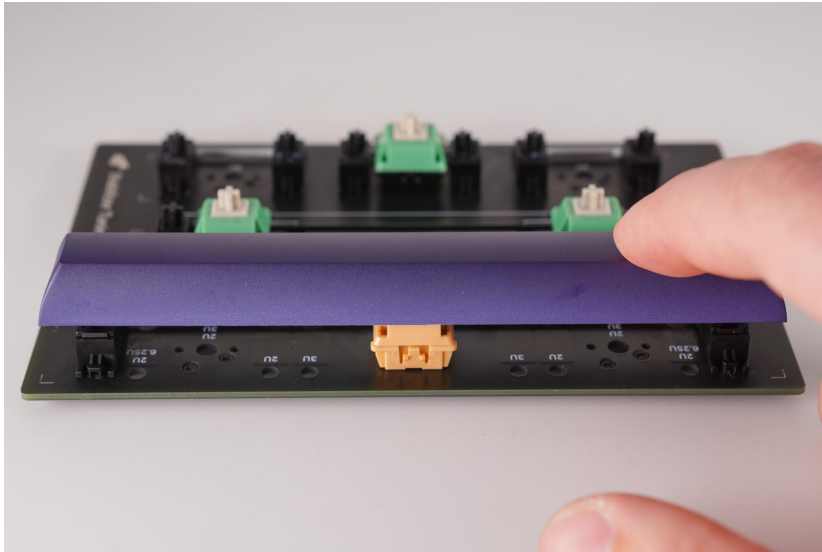
2. Gently move the screwdriver towards the outside, then back inside





3. After one cycle of back and forth, examine the stem and place the spacebar onto your assembled stabilizer and switch. Test the return and see if the bar is functioning properly.





4. If it is still not returning properly, repeat steps 1-3
