

A9100 – Exterior Alkyd Primer

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

A9100 Exterior Alkyd Primer is a pure Soya Alkyd Primer exhibiting excellent sealing, stain blocking and mildew resistance characteristics for application in most residential or commercial environments. A9100 Exterior Alkyd Primer is specifically formulated to seal most common exterior stains and will adhere tenaciously to a variety of surfaces.

Surface preparation

Free surface of all contaminants such as dirt, dust, oil, grease, wax, and rust. Remove mildew using a chlorine bleach solution of 1 to 4 ratio of bleach to water. Patch holes and cracks, sand smooth and remove sanding dust.

New Wood: Sand smooth and remove dust. Spot Prime all knots with C₂ Exterior Alkyd Primer. Apply one coat of C₂ Exterior Alkyd Primer to entire surface.

Painted Surfaces: Remove loose and peeling paint. Dull glossy areas. Apply one coat of C₂ Exterior Alkyd Primer.

Application

A9100 Exterior Alkyd Primer may be applied by roller (no more than 3/8-inch nap), brush (pure china bristle) or spray.

Spreading Rate: Product should be applied at a rate of 400 to 450 square feet per gallon (37 to 42 square meters per 3.78 liters).

Thinning: Do not thin.

Airless Spray: Use a 12 to 15 mil size tip.

Cleanup: Clean painting equipment and spills immediately using mineral spirits.

Limitations: Do not apply if product, air, or surface temperature is below 50° F (10° C) - Keep product from freezing. Product application and surface conditions are beyond the manufacturer's control. Liability, if any, is limited to replacement of product only.

Disposal: Do not dispose of any paint product or solvent in drains, sewers, or municipal garbage. See your C₂ dealer for disposal recommendations in your area.
