



iPhone 6/6S appliance guide

1. Clean the backside of your iPhone and place it with the screen down. Make sure the surface you place the phone upon is clean, to avoid any scratches in the screen.



2. Separate the skin from the back-paper and place it on the iPhone. The process consists of two steps. First the backside is placed, then the sides are done with a hair dryer.



The skin should be laid down on the iPhone gradually from the top to the bottom of the phone. Start by fitting up the holes for the camera/flash, then the Apple logo, and the bottom at last.



The holes for the camera/flash and the Apple logo must align perfectly, and at the bottom of the skin, the distance from the skin to the corner should be the same on both sides, when looked upon from above, as shown in the pictures below.



Should you at some point during the process discover you haven't aligned everything as you like, you can peel it off again, in one quick swift motion, and then try again.

3. When the skin is fitted perfectly on the back, rub it in place with your fingers. Then go grab a hair dryer to fit the sides of the skin to the iPhone.
4. In order for the skin to stick properly onto the curving edges of the iPhone, a small amount of heat is needed to soften the skin during the appliance, for it to follow the curves correctly.
Use a hair dryer on the highest heat setting for a few seconds, to heat and soften the sides of the skin, before rubbing it on with your finger.



Start with the sides, one at the time, and top and bottom for last. Warm the edges of the skin for a few seconds and then rub it hard with your finger until the skin sits on the phone's edges. The longer you rub, the better it will get stuck on the phone. You cannot overdo this, or do this too much.



If some of the edges or corners won't stick properly, you can always warm it up quickly a second time, and then rub it again until it stays stuck. Again, the more the better. After a few hours the skin will have attached fully, but is of course just as easy to remove as the iPhone 4/5 skins were.

The skin leaves no traces on the phone when removed (you just peel it off with your fingers) but can however not be reused when first removed.
