
## **Drop Down Loft Access Door Operating Instructions**

CODE **GL250/03** 

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Turn the catch 90° clockwise to open the door (Fig.1).

This can be done from floor level using a pole as supplied with the Manthorpe Loft Ladder (Code GL256) or using a similar pole with the attachment provided (affixed to the back of the door).









The door can be completely removed from its frame for ease of access if required.



To remove the door, open beyond the vertical (as Fig.3) and then slide sideways slightly to disengage one hinge then the other.



To replace the door, offer up to the frame at the angle as shown (Fig.5). Locate one of the hinge lugs into place in the frame. Still holding at the same angle locate the second lug.

Centralise the door in the frame and close.

Turn the catch 90° anti-clockwise to secure the door into position. The catch will click when properly closed.
