FOOT MEASUREMENT SHEET

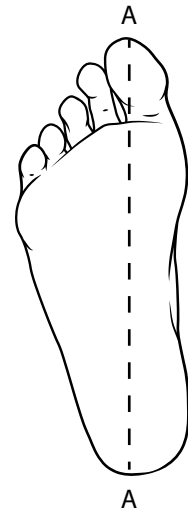

Tape the Footprint Sheet (page 2) on the floor and follow the instructions written there.

Write down linear length A for both feet
(please note: measure the footprint you
made on the sheet, not the feet)

left cm

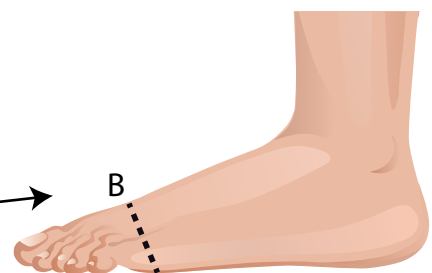
right cm



Write down Circumference B for both feet

left cm

right cm





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PLACE THIS SHEET ON THE FLOOR

(better if you tape it)

Sit with your foot firmly on the floor, over the sheet, and your leg bent slightly forward so that your shin is slightly in front of your ankle.

Trace the outline of your foot and remember to measure your foot without shoes, but with socks similar to the ones you'll be wearing with the shoes you are buying.

Hold the pencil or pen upright and perpendicular to the paper.
Do not hold it at an angle.

Make sure the pencil is resting snugly against your foot as you draw around it.

You may actually find it helpful to have someone else trace your foot, but it can be done alone



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Measure the **circumference** (not linear length) of leg and foot as shown in figure. Please measure the required **circumference** with tights, leggings and/or trousers as the boots will be worn with them on.

Do for both legs and note down.
