


# O2 The handy guide to skip hire


# 03 What skip size do I need?

There are lots of things to consider when choosing the right size skip. Such as do I have enough room on my property for any size skip to be placed? If there is no room for the skip to be placed on private property then it will have to go on the road. This means two things firstly you will have to pay an additional permit charge (as discussed later) and secondly the biggest skip you can have is an 8 yard.

What size skip you need depends on how much waste you will have. Whilst bigger skips cost more money it is sometimes best to be safe, as one big skip is much cheaper than two smaller skips. For help in choosing the right size for you have a look at our handy graphic on the next page.

What sized skip you might need obviously depends on how much work you are doing, from a 4-yard skip for some garden work or tidying out a room in your house through to 12-yard skips for your larger projects at home or work. For a guide to what size you might want, have a look at our handy graphic on the next page.




Ideal for a small clearout, bathroom or kitchen refit.











# 06 What can I put in my skip?

Something which everyone needs to be aware of is what you can actually put in the skip.

Many people will assume that you can just throw anything you like into a skip, and perhaps in years gone by that was true. Due to various environmental laws implemented over the years and the practicalities of modern recycling, there are now many things that you cannot dispose of this way. A general rule of thumb is that you can't dispose of anything in a skip that might be potentially toxic and harmful, or that couldn't be recycled.

## The list of items we can't accept includes:

- Fridges/freezers
- Paints/Solvents/Aerosols
- Asbestos
- Tyres
- Plasterboard
- Mattresses

- Clinical/ medical waste
- Batteries
- Florescent tubes
- TVs/Electronics/ WEEE Equipment
- Oil
- Astroturf
- Soft furnishings

Most of the banned items are included on our list but, if you are ever in doubt, it's best to check with us first. Toxic waste especially could mean that your skip company refuses to take your waste and would potentially land you in trouble with local authorities.



# 07 Who can hire a skip?






# 08 What permits and licences do I need?

If you dont have a driveway, garden or private space for the skip to go on leaving a hired skip on the road may be your only option. For anyone who plans to keep a skip anywhere that isn't their land, such as public roads, pavements and pathways, permission is needed from the owner or local authority.

Most councils will allow skip hire companies to apply for permits on your behalf, making the task lots easier for you and cutting down on paperwork, though some still require private registration. If this is the case, you will need to make sure that permits are arranged before your skip arrives, and they can take a few days to process.

The majority of skip permits, whether self-arranged or not, will put some restrictions on how and where you can keep your skip. Please be aware all skips placed on a public highway need to have lights and cones. We will supply where possible and they can also be hired from many builders merchants and hire centres.



#### Most often these rules include:

- Skips shouldn't completely block pavements and the entrance or exit to any building or property
- Utility access points, such as drains and manhole covers shouldn't be covered by a skip
- Traffic laws mean that skips can't be placed within 15m of any junction, so as not to obscure vision for motorists
- If your skip is placed across yellow lines or is in a pay-and-display bay you might need to arrange a suspension of parking laws

Even if you arrange a permit yourself, skip companies will be able to advise you on the best place to have your skip and move it for you into the safest location. Our friendly team are always on hand to advise if you need to arrange the permit yourself.

Please allow 7 days to obtain a permit. Once in place permits are only valid for 14 days.




# 10 How to keep your skip safe and secure

In addition to the rules imposed by having a skip licence, there are certain things that you will be required to do to make sure that your skip is kept safe and isn't a danger to motorists or passers-by.

#### These include:

- The contact name and phone number of the skip hire company should always be displayed clearly on the side of any skip
- Reflective markings should be used around the edges of the skip, especially if it is placed on the road
- If it is actually in the road, traffic cones should be used to guide traffic around it

Although fulfilling safety regulations should be arranged by your skip hire company, you risk a £1,000 fine if they are broken - so it's always worth checking them yourself when you receive your skip. Many local councils enforce their own restrictions too, so it is wise to consult local authorities first if you aren't sure on the rules.




# 11 Can other people use your skip?

In the eyes of the law, whoever hires a skip, whether it's placed on public or private land, is responsible for all of the waste in it. If anything is thrown into your skip without your knowledge, such as hazardous waste, or if the skip becomes over full, it can pose a danger to the public, be refused collection and land you hefty fines from local authorities. Equally, if someone takes waste out of your skip and doesn't dispose of it properly, just fly tips it nearby, the fines will land on your doorstep.

There were more than 700,000 incidents of fly tipping in the UK last year, mostly consisting of domestic waste, which cost the economy and estimated £36.4million. Whilst other people can use your skip if you choose to let them, there are risks involved for you.

To prevent any potential fines, to stop people rummaging through your waste and avoid illegal rubbish ending up in your skip, using a cover is advised. Many open top skips can be fitted with covers overnight to prevent access, whilst some skip companies will offer closed skips with lockable lids to provide a more secure option.
