




Alphabet Shape Posters

How to Use







Hang on a bulletin board, use as a word wall, or hang along a high wall as an alphabet



Have kids read the words on the posters to build letter recognition and letter-sound knowledge.



Alphabet spot the Letter Mats

How-to Use

These alphabet letter mats will help your students develop their phonemic awareness. Have them count or circle the pictures that start with the letter sound with a white board marker!

Print in color and laminate the spot the letter mats or use in pocket protectors and have your students search for a given letter and circle pictures that start with a given letter. There are many pictures to find on the mat, as well as upper and lowercase letters.




Alphabet Letter Ties

How-to use

Students will enjoy practicing each letter of the alphabet in style as they create their own letter tie.

Trace the letter, fill in the letter box (to form words that begin with that letter), and color pictures. Instructions with pictures on how to make the ties hang around necks are included.









Alphabet Make & Print


How-to use

Print out the make and print pages on cardstock and laminate for durability. Put them in your literacy center with Play-Doh for students to practice their letter formation and handwriting skills. This would also be a fun activity in your small groups.











Alphabet Find & Color


How-to use

Photocopy and make booklets for your students or use pages individually for letter-sound practice.

Kids look for things that start with the letter and color those pictures. After they can count how many objects and trace the








Alphabet Strip Crafts

How-to use

There are 26 letter crafts to make (I for each letter). Each craft has up to 7 pieces to cut out and use. There is one large piece with the letter and up to 6 pictures that start with each letter of the alphabet.

They can be cut out, colored, and glued by students. I suggest gluing the pieces on long strips of construction paper or poster board. They are great for helping students learn words that begin with that letter and to develop phonemic awareness.






Alphabet Mini-Books

How-to Use

Print out the page for the letter, cut along the lines, and staple the pages to make a mini book with pictures to go with each letter. These mini-books are great for small groups, guided reading, and homework practice. You students will love making and practicing these mini-books!








Alphabet How-to Use

These non-fiction alphabet books (I for each letter of the alphabet) feature photographs of things that start with that letter. Print off and cut along the dotted lines. Assemble the pages to make mini books. You can glue onto colored paper to create a bright look!

These books are great for teaching your students about initial sounds and to help with developing phonemic awareness





Alphabet Letter Search

How-to use

Print out the letter search pages as needed or make a student booklet. Have your students search for upper and lower case letters on the page and mark them with bingo dabbers or circles. After they can count how many they found and trace that number.






Alphabet Flash Cards

How-to use

Print out the alphabet flash cards on cardstock and laminate. Cut them out and use for various things. Flash cards are great for your small group activities and games. Put a set in your literacy centers and allow your students to play games with them.





Alphabet Puzzles

How-to use

Your students will love learning the alphabet as they match piece in these alphabet puzzles. Each puzzle has an upper and lowercase letter and 2 pictures that start with that letter.

Print and laminate for durability. These puzzles are great for centers and come in color and black and white.








Alphabet Color & Print

How-to Use

Photocopy and make booklets for your students. Have your class look for things that start with the letter that you are studying in class and color those objects. There are 3 lines for your students to practice their printing.







Alphabet Handwriting Posters

How-to use

Print out the alphabet handwriting posters on cardstock and laminate. Use them when you are teaching your students about letter formation. Post the posters as a reference. Put a set of posters in your literacy centers for students to practice.










Alphabet Dot Pages

How-to Use

Students can practice forming upper and lowercase letters with these dot to dot activities. Directional arrows are included to help your students form letters correctly. Great to use with bingo stamps or Do-a-Dot markers.







How-to Use

This is a bright and colorful alphabet for you to post in the classroom or on a bulletin board. It features real photographs of items starting with each letter of the alphabet. Great to use as a reference or in your literacy center area. You could shrink and print as flash cards. Helpful for ESL students.







Alphabet Read & Write the Room

How-to use

Photocopy the stack of sheets and cut in half to make 2 booklets. Staple and add student names. Students look for things that start with the letter that you are studying in class. These booklets work great for literacy centers or small group activities!

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
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
