Alberta

Alberta is Canada's 2nd most western province. It borders by the Rocky Mountains into British Columbia, Saskatchewan, Northwest Territories, and Montana in the United States.



Calgary, Alberta

Edmonton is the capital city of Alberta. The provincial flower of Alberta is the Wild Rose. The provincial bird is the Great Horned Owl. Alberta is home to over 4 million people. Calgary is Alberta's largest and one of its most populated cities, along with Edmonton. Alberta is a province with diverse climates and landscapes (prairies and mountains).



The Rocky Mountains

Alberta has one of the strongest economies with a lower cost-of-living, lower taxes, and many job opportunities. It offers natural gas, oil, coal, and minerals to the rest of Canada and the world.

New Brunswick

New Brunswick is the largest of Canada's maritime provinces on the east coast. It borders the Bay of Fundy, the Gulf of St. Lawrence, Quebec, and Maine in the United States.



Black-capped Chickadee

New Brunswick is home to over 750 thousand people. Saint John is its largest and one of its most populated cities, along with Moncton and Fredericton. New Brunswick is Canada's only official bilingual province. About 33% of the population speak French.

Fredericton is the capital city of New Brunswick. The provincial flower of the New Brunswick is the Purple Violet. The provincial bird is the Black-capped Chickadee.



The Confederation Bridge

Nunavut

Nunavut is the largest of the 3 Canadian territories. It borders the Northwest Territories to the north, and small areas of Newfoundland and Labrador, Saskatchewan, Quebec, Ontario, and Greenland.



Nunavut Sunrise

Nunavut is the largest in area Canada with the lowest population. It is home to over 40,000 people, mostly Inuit. Iqaluit is the capital city of Nunavut.

Nunavut is the newest territory of Canada, having separated officially in 1999 from the Northwest Territories. Iqaluit on Baffin Bay is the capital city of Nunavut.
