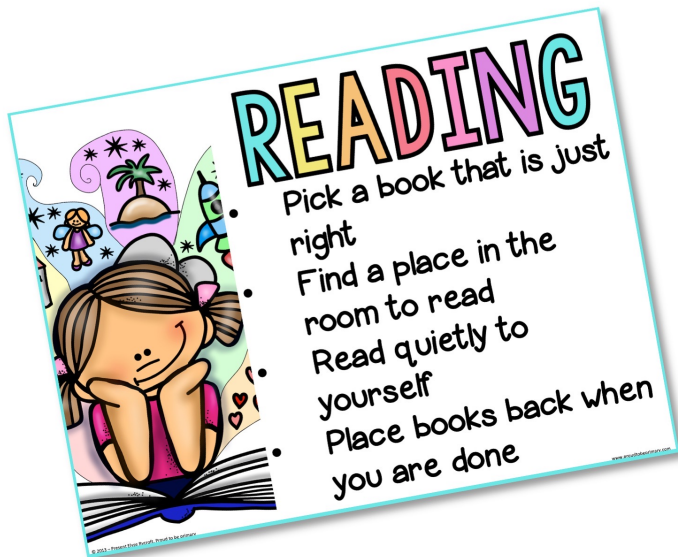


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## Rule Explanation Posters

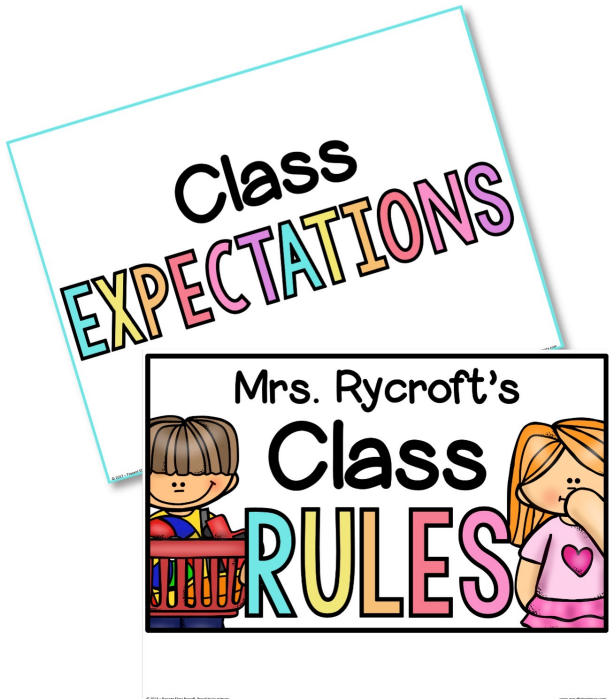


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## Bulletin Board Headers & Posters

Bulletin board letters, headers, and posters are included to help you create an area that works best for your classroom space and your students. There are black & white versions available, as well as color.



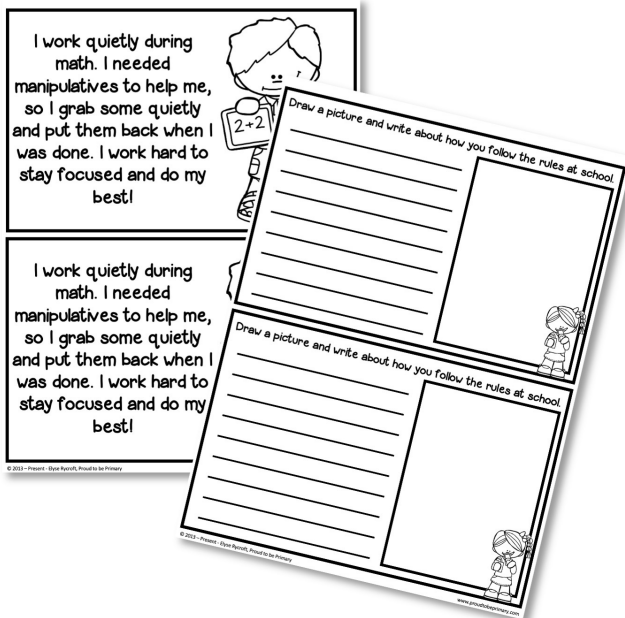


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## "We Follow the Rules" Storybook

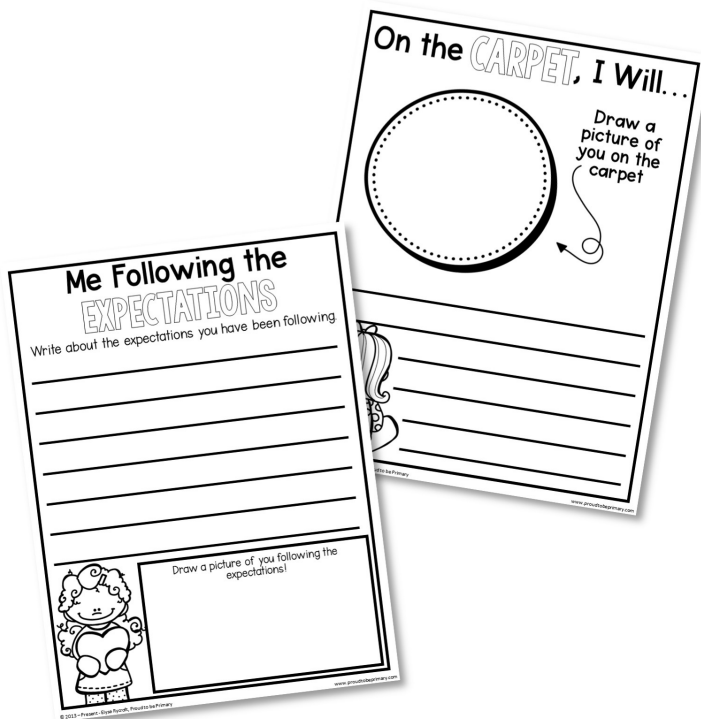


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## Writing Templates

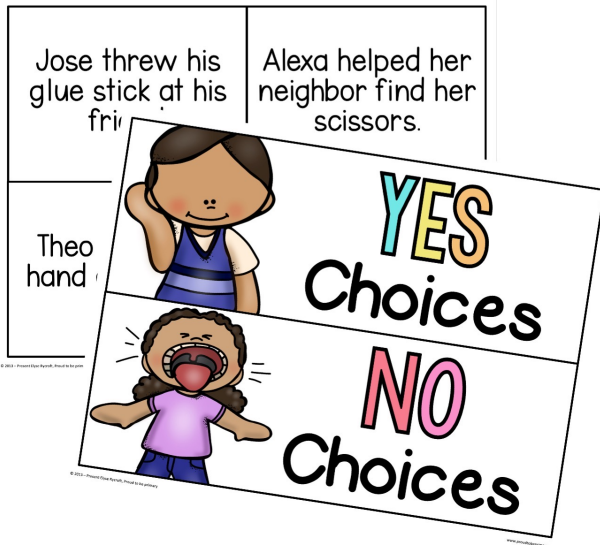


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## Sorting Activity

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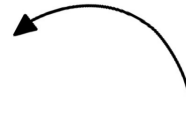


# CLASS RULES

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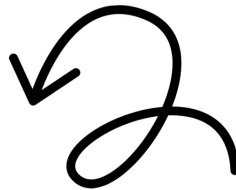
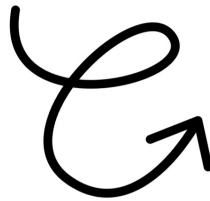
