24 Classroom Door Hangers


Use the door hangers to let others know where you are throughout the day and in the school building. Allow students to switch out the door hangers as a job each time you leave or return to your classroom.


Different Ways to Simplify Transitions



Add door hangers to your door to let students and others in the school know where your class is throughout the day.


Place call-back cards in a pocket chart so they are easy to use and switch up!
