Gratitude Mini-Lessons & Activities


Discuss what it means to be grateful, and all the things around us that we are thankful for. These activities are perfect for discussing, reflecting, and sharing when it comes to gratitude.























Teach and encourage students to discuss what it means to have good manners. These activities give your students a variety of ways to identify and practice what it means to use manners and the importance of being polite.

















Respect Mini-Lessons & Activities


Discuss what it means to show respect to those around you. Your students will learn how it feels when someone shows respect them and how it makes others feel when they are respectful as well.















Diversity & Inclusion Activities




Diversity and inclusion are really important both in and out of the classroom. Teach students what it means to be different and how important it is to include everyone while embracing their unique qualities.




