Father's Day Coupons



Father's Day Mini Book



Reading Challenge & Bookmarks



Poetry Activities



Father's Day Trophy Craft



Father's Day Games



Building with Dad STEM Activities


Complete fun STEM activities with dad for Father's Day! The students can take home the STEM task cards and work on the tasks with their dad!

Father's Day Survey




