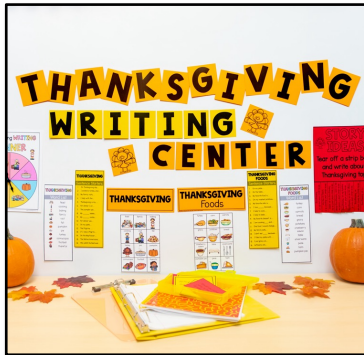

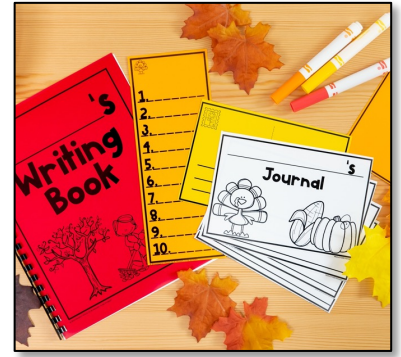

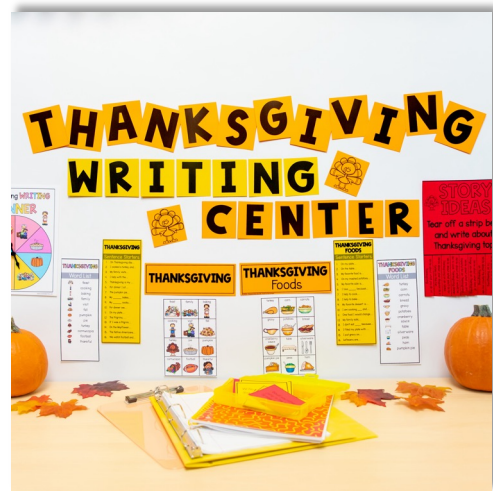

- A variety of prompts, sentence starters, and templates give students lots of choices as they create writing they're proud of and excited to share!

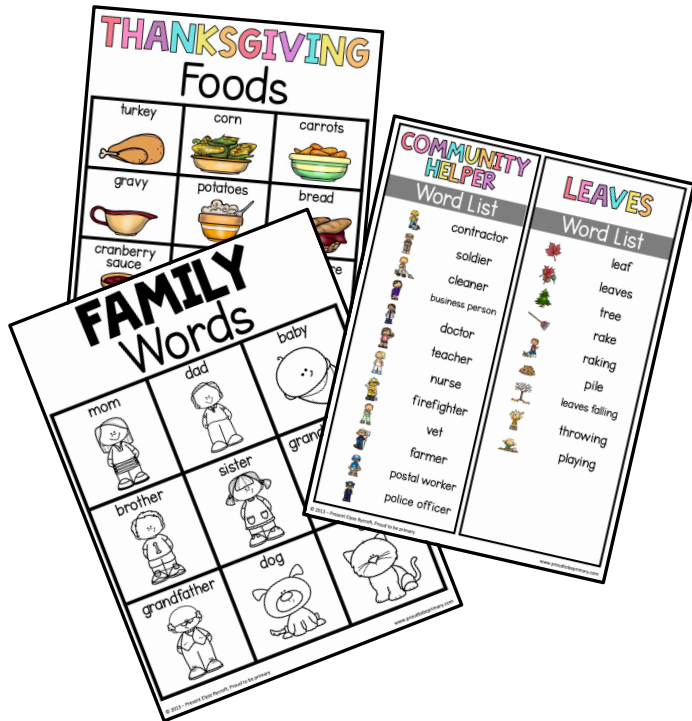
