

Blend Sentences

Fill-In's

Kids use the word list at the bottom of the page as a guide to help them figure out which words go in each spot. They need to read the sentences and print the missing words on the lines.





Read, Trace, Draw Mini Books

Two types of mini-books are included. Each require kids to cut and put together. Kids read and trace the word family words, then draw pictures or color the provided pictures.




List Sheet

A sheet for each blend in the blend family is provided. Choose the sheets you would like children to practice and create a booklet. They list the words for a blend independently or copy after coming up with a class list of words.

Read & Write the Room

Students use the mini-book to read and write words from around the room, from each blend. Use the word/picture cards provided to post around the room for students to find, read, and write.



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Matching Blends

In this activity, kids cut pictures that start with a certain blend and glue it in the correct location to match the word.





Word Search

In this fun favorite, kids will search for words that begin with a certain blend and circle it after. To keep track, they can cross of the words in the word bank.

Sort the Blend

Kids will practice reading and sorting a list of words that begin with different consonant blends. They will write it in the correct spot and cross off words as they go.

Color by Blend

Kids will enjoy coloring these fun, mystery pictures that are revealed as they color. They will read the words and color them to correspond to the color key provided.





Spin & Cover

Print and laminate for kids to use to practice identifying beginning blends. Kids will spin the spinner and find a word that starts with that blend. Great for literacy centers, word work, or small groups. The black & white option is perfect for coloring!

Fill In The Blend

Kids can practice identifying the missing blend with these mixed blend activities. Kids will look at the picture and fill in the first two letters to complete the word.




