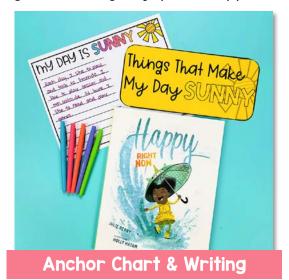
Activities

Happiness Mini-Lessons & Activities

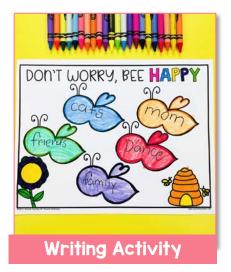
Discuss what it means to be happy. These activities are perfect for discussing, identifying, and sharing activities and things that bring us joy and happiness.

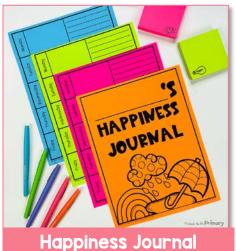

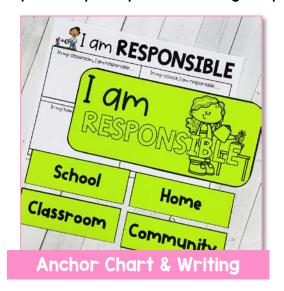




Responsibility & Decision Making

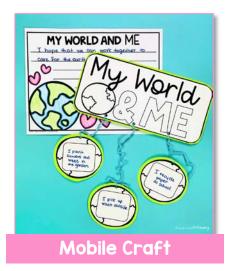


Teach and encourage students to be responsible and make good decisions. These activities give your students a variety of ways to practice being responsible and how their choices reflect that.







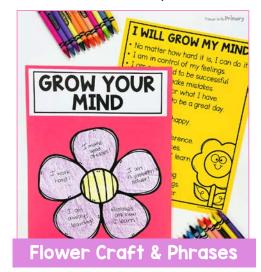




Growth Mindset Activities

Teaching kids how to manage their emotions effectively is an important skill that requires practice. Teach students how to identify their emotions and use different tools to manage emotions and self-regulate.



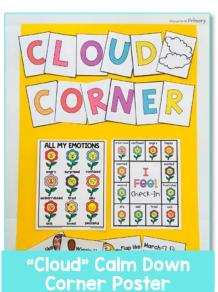

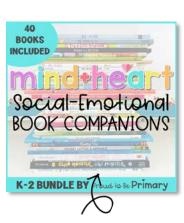
