



#### **Posters & Bulletin Board**

Display your "Thankful Little Turkeys" work this fall using the provided bulletin board letters and posters. You can display the included turkey crafts, writing prompts, or anything related to decorate your student work board.





#### **Feelings Chart**

Display your "Turkey Feelings" clip chart and have student's check-in emotionally every day. A great activity to add to your morning routine to encourage kids to recognize their feelings and the feelings of their classmates.





#### **Turkey Vocabulary**

Display turkey vocabulary words to support students as they write this fall. These also provide creative ideas to add to stories. Turkey words are included in strips and cards (color and black & white) to add to a ring or use in a pocket chart. There are also word sheets for students to draw and write a definition for a student-created display.





#### Writing Prompts & Page Toppers

Choose from a variety of different writing prompts to make writing fun this fall! Students can select a page topper to add to the top of their page and write about it. These activities will help encourage and build creative writing skills as you discuss turkeys.





#### **Turkey Disguise Project Book Companion**

Read the book *How to Catch a Turkey* with your students and use the included activities for a turkey disguise project. The activities include writing prompts, parent letter, and craft for students to use to create a disguise for a turkey. Includes a variety of paper costumes to use or kids can be creative and make their own disguise.





#### **Turkey Kindness Challenge**


Complete a turkey kindness challenge as a class. When a student completes an act of kindness, write it on a feather, and attach to the turkey body template. Fill up the turkey throughout the month of November to show all the acts of kindness your students have completed.






#### **Turkey Life Cycle Info Sheet**

Read the turkey life cycle info sheet together. Students can answer comprehension questions about the info sheet on a worksheet independently or together as a class. Included are other life cycle materials for students to bring home to share with their families or complete on their own.





#### **No-Prep Games**

Use the turkey games as a partner activity, time filler, center, or a fun anytime activity to help kids practice their math skills. They are also the perfect addition to your fall party or Thanksgiving discussions. The 3 games included are *Turkey Eye-Spy, Turkey Roll and Color*, and *Turkey Race* (instructions included).





#### **Math Activities & Crafts**


Add the turkey-themed math activities and crafts to your math center and independent worktime. Three differentiated levels of number centers are included. There are also no-prep math worksheets and two math crafts (number hats FIO and shape craft) to practice patterning, numbers, addition and subtraction.





#### **Build a Turkey Trap STEM**

Students work together to build a trap for their turkey!
Use different materials around the classroom and set a
plan for a trap. Bring the trap to life with your materials
and try to trap the paper turkey!





#### **Turkey Getaway STEM**

Help the turkey get away! Build a turkey getaway with a toilet paper tube or other object and some string. Attach the string to a higher and a lower surface and see what it takes to get the turkey down the string! Test different objects and see what types of getaways you can create.





#### **Turkey Hideout STEM**

Create a turkey hideout so the turkey doesn't get caught. Use different items in the classroom to construct the perfect hideout and write about what you created. Hide the paper turkey inside. Discuss the differences between the hideouts.





#### 2 Turkey Life Cycle Books

Walk through the turkey life cycle with a fill-in-the-blank storybook. Students draw pictures on each turkey page to match the life cycle story and staple the pages together.





Create a turkey flap book on the life cycle. There are differentiated options and templates to choose from. Students fill in the life cycle parts and label each flap.

#### **Turkey Crafts**

Create a turkey hat to represent the turkey life cycle or a Thankful turkey to share gratitude. Students color and cut a turkey, glue the pieces in place to create a turkey craft.







For the hat, glue the life cycle pieces in order on the hat, connect with a strip of paper and attach it around the head. For the gratitude craft, write things they are thankful for on the feathers and write on the prompt.

#### **Turkey Directed Drawing**


Learn to draw a turkey with this fun directed drawing activity. Your students will practice following directions as they draw a turkey for fall or Thanksgiving! There are 4 and 6 step options included to allow for differentiation.
