**SALMON Appearance**

Salmon have long, silvery bodies, with dark backs. Their skin helps them hide in the water from predators. They are covered with scales. A lateral line down its back tells it when food or enemies are close. Their gills take in oxygen from the water to help them breathe. Salmon bodies are built for swimming. They have strong bodies that can jump and swim upstream against powerful currents. Their fins help them balance and swim in different directions. Salmon have backbones that flex when swimming. Salmon change color or turn red when they are spawning and producing eggs.

**New Ladybug** New ladybugs are born from eggs. They are very small and are a soft red color.

**Adult Ladybug** Adult ladybugs are larger than new ladybugs. They are a bright red color with black spots.

**Eggs** Ladybug eggs are small and round. They are yellow and are attached to the ladybug's body.

**Larvae** Ladybug larvae are small and worm-like. They are yellow and black and have long antennae.

**Pupa** Ladybug pupae are small and worm-like. They are yellow and black and have long antennae.

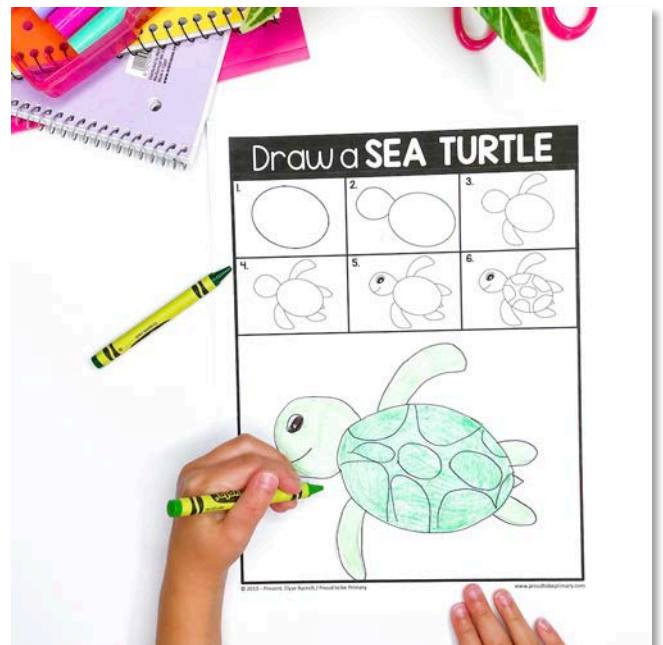
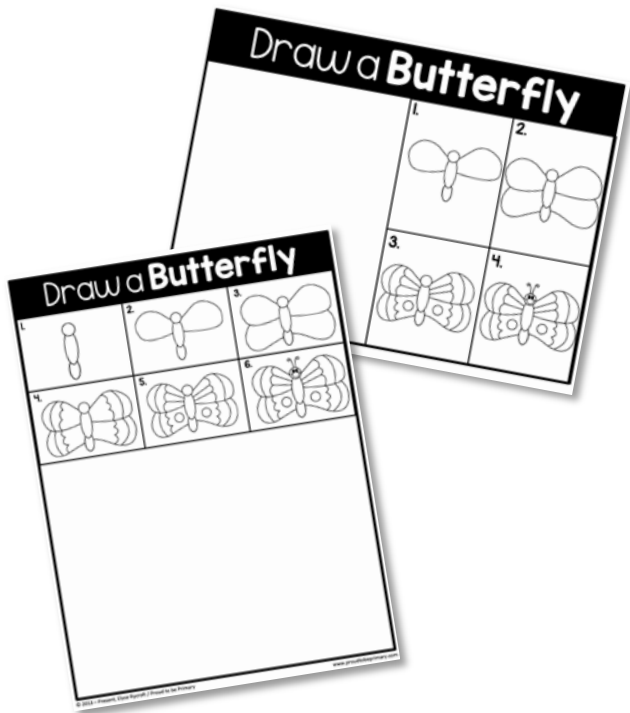
## Fact Finding Activities
