





3. Draw two small curved shapes on both sides of the head to form the inner ears. Draw a oval shape for the nose.

4. Draw two small curved shapes on both sides of the head to form the outer ears. Draw a oval shape for the nose.

5. Draw two small curved shapes on both sides of the head to form the inner ears. Draw a oval shape for the nose.

6. Color in the bottom section of both eyes. Add small circles with tiny 'x's in them inside the collar for bells. Add a half smile below the nose.





3. To form the rest of its body, draw two more curved lines from the arms to meet in the center to form legs.



4. Draw two circles for eyes and a smile on its face. Draw three small circles down the front of its body.



5. Color in the eyes leaving a white area near the edge. Draw a small circle on each end of its smile.



6. Draw a set of curvy lines on each arm and each leg.
