
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
Crack The Code



Students piece together five piece puzzles: four sounds and a picture. Once all puzzles are completed, they can fill in the recording form with the words.



Kids can clip all the pictures in the given ending blend: -LF, -ND, -RL, -CT. Once they are done clipping the cards, they can record their answers.






Build The CCVC Words

These task cards are the perfect way to practice verbs. Kids will work through the cards and fill out their answers on the recording sheet.




