**Directed Drawing - Bus**

Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

1. Start with a straight line going across the center. Curve the corner of each end and draw straight lines down. Draw a curved arch going up and over the center line for the window.
2. For the bumper, draw two parallel, straight lines going across that curve on the ends. Draw a rectangular shape with curved edges around the arch and the top of the bus.
3. Draw a small, rectangular, curved shape on each side of the bus. Draw a straight line going across above the arch, leaving space above it. Draw a straight line going across under the window. Add two tire shapes under the bumper.
4. Draw a small circle on both the top of the bus. Draw a small circle on both sides of the bus. Make each circle a size.
5. Draw a small circle on both the top of the bus. Draw a small circle on both sides of the bus. Make each circle a size.
6. Color in the inner circles of the eyes. Write the word "SCHOOL" in between the two small circles at the top of the bus.





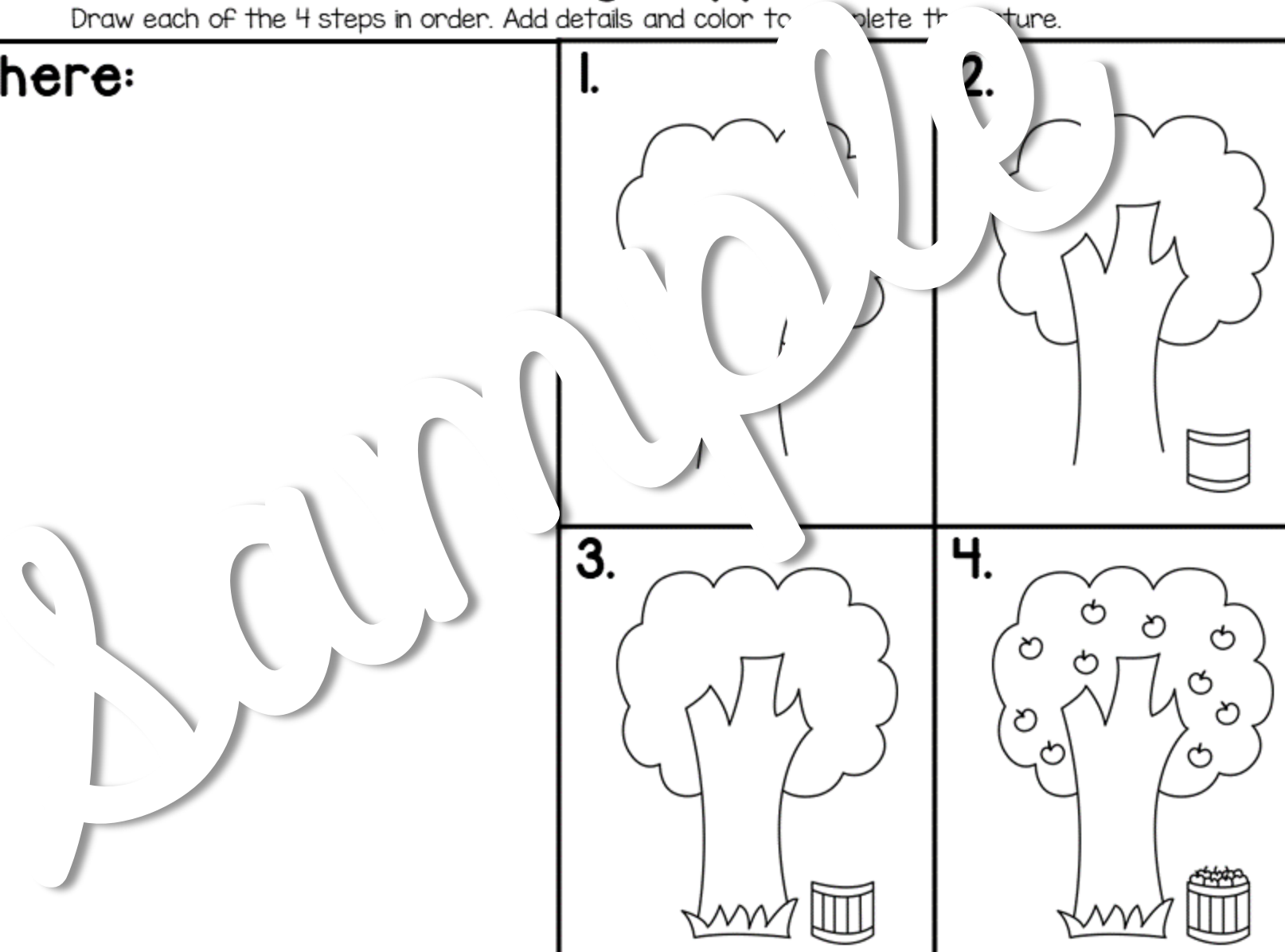

## Directed Drawing - Book Worm

Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

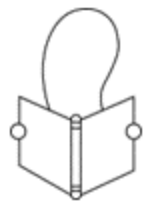
**1.** Draw the shape of an open book (two wide V shapes on top of each other connected with a straight line down on each end).



**2.** Add the spine of the book by drawing two straight lines going down the center. Add two small lines on the top and bottom of the spine.



**3.** Draw a small circle on each side of the book for the worm's eyes. Draw a curved shape over the top of the book for the worm's head.



**4.** Draw two circles for the worm's eyes. Draw a curved wiggly line coming from under the book. Draw another curved wiggly line beside the worm's hand. Have both lines meet together.



**5.** Draw a smile with two tiny circles for each end. Draw a curved line inside each eye.



**6.** Fill in each eye leaving a small white part. Draw a tiny line in the center and on both sides of the eyes to form glasses. Add three curved lines inside the worm's body.

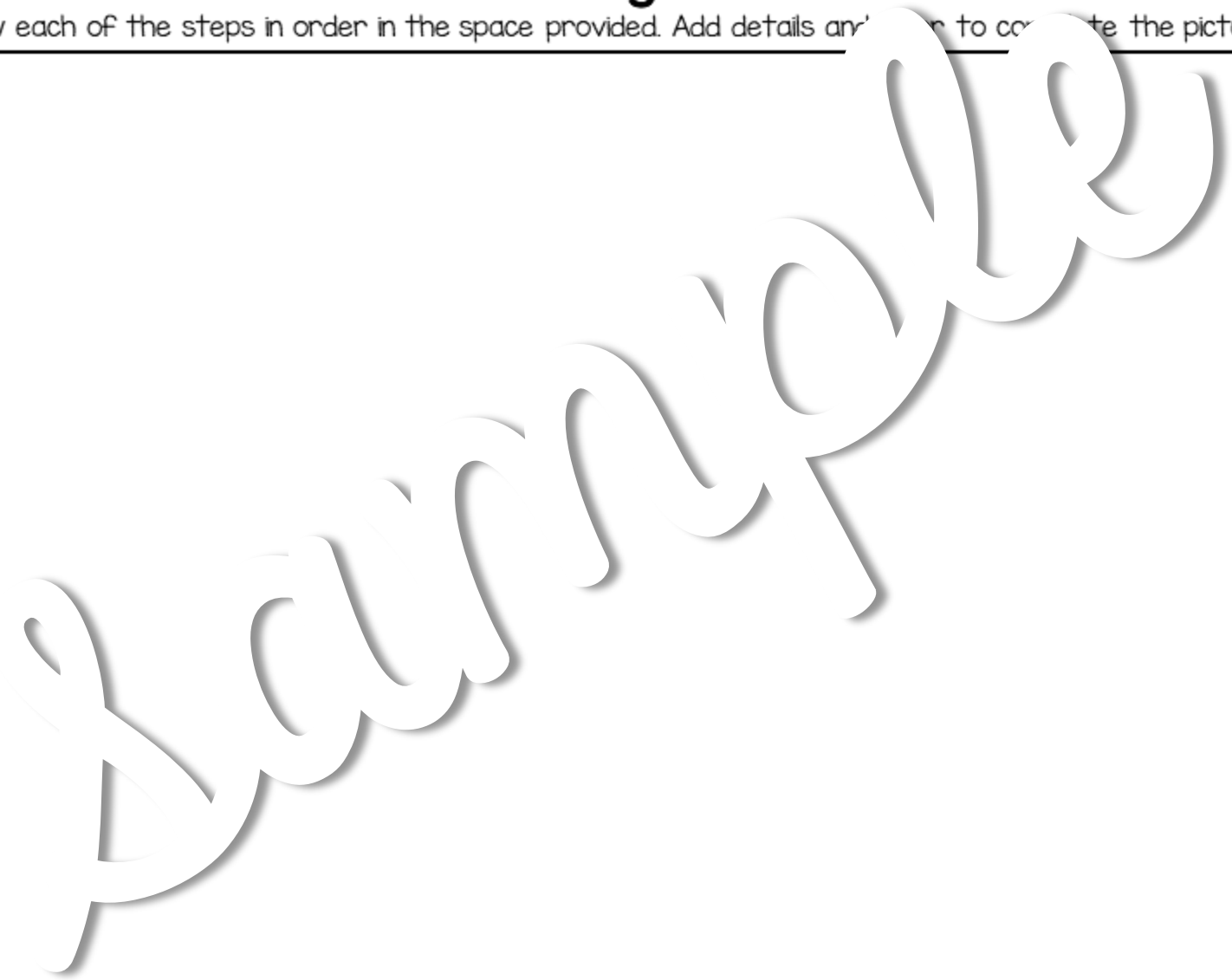
