End your year with a sense of community by reflecting on all that was done. Children will discuss their accomplishments, goals, and skills they've used along the way.




















Discuss strengths and weaknesses from throughout the year. Learn about each other's favorite parts, challenging moments, and ways that we have learned how to overcome them.












Looking Forward - Goal Setting Activities

Friendships - Party Week Activities






End of the Year DIGITAL SEL ACTIVITIES


