Directed Drawing - Tooth Fairy



Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

1. Draw a 'U' shape for the face outline. Draw a small straight line on top of the head.

2. Draw a curved line up from the face to form the hairline. Draw two parallel straight lines down for the sides of the body. Draw two tiny lines down to form the neck.

3. Draw an upside down 'U' shape wider than the face attached to the neck for the hair around the face.

6. Draw two tiny ears on both sides of the face. Color in the eyes leaving small white areas. Draw a tiny 'U' shape for the nose and a larger 'U' shape for the smile. Draw a skiny rectangle ward with a small tooth shape on the end.



Directed Drawing - Chinese Dragon

Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

1. Draw a curved triangle for the dragon's head. Draw a curved shape across the face for the nose.



2. Draw two curved lines to start forming the dragon's body. Draw the outline of the eyes above the nose. Draw tiny triangles along the top of the head.



3. Draw the 'fins' of the dragon. Draw two curved lines to connect the body to the head.



4. Draw a triangle shape under the nose to form the mouth. Draw lines forming the body in four sections.



5. Draw a squiggly line over the top of the body. Draw two sets of curved lines to outline the eyes. Draw two tiny circles inside the nose.



6. Draw and color in two small circles inside the eyes. Draw curved lines over each eyes. Draw tiny triangles for teeth inside the mouth.

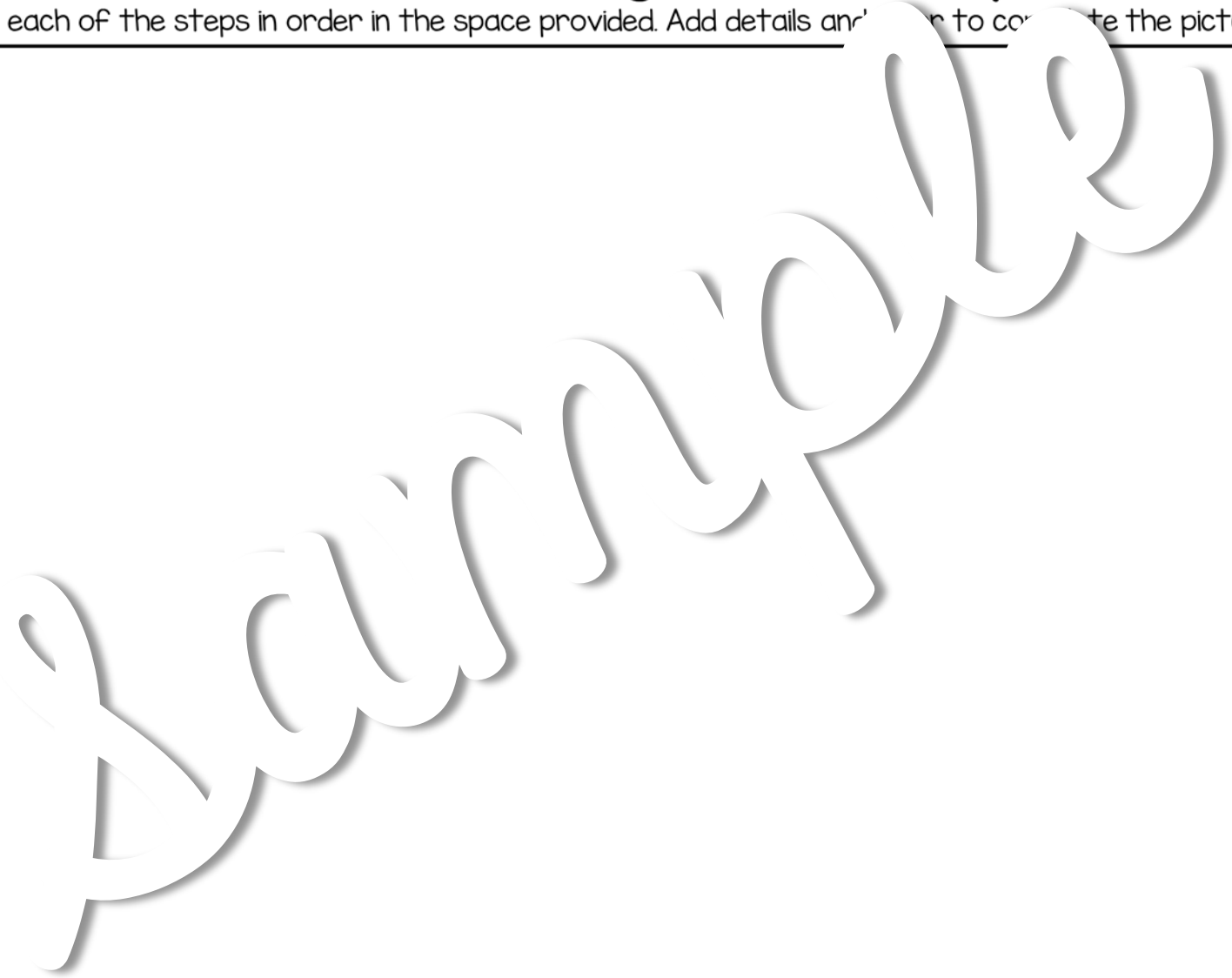
