1. For the sea turtle's shell, draw a large oval shape tilted to the left.

2. For its head, draw a circular shape coming out of the top of its shell (top left side).

3. For its flippers, draw a curved shape that comes out at each side of the turtle's shell and goes down towards its tail and back up to its sides.

4. For its eye, draw a large part of it colored in two white sections (outer part).

6. For the scutes on the shell, draw a circular shape in the center with more circular shapes all the way around it attached to the sides of the shell.

1. Draw a long, horizontal curved shape to form a sand mound.



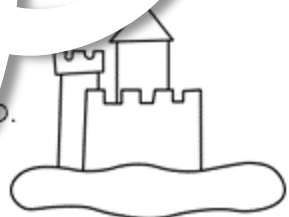
2. For the center part of the sandcastle, draw two straight lines coming up from the sand mound. Draw small straight lines going across, down, and up all the way.



3. For the top part of the sandcastle, draw a rectangle coming up from the center of the top part. Draw a triangle on top.



4. For the pillar of the sandcastle, draw a straight line coming up beside and above the center part. Draw a small rectangle on top of the pillar with two circular dips along the top.



5. Draw a pillar on the right side that is the same one on the left.



6. Draw a small flag coming out of the top triangle. Draw a mini rectangle in the center of the top pillar. Draw two rectangle shapes, one within the other, in front of the center part of the sandcastle.

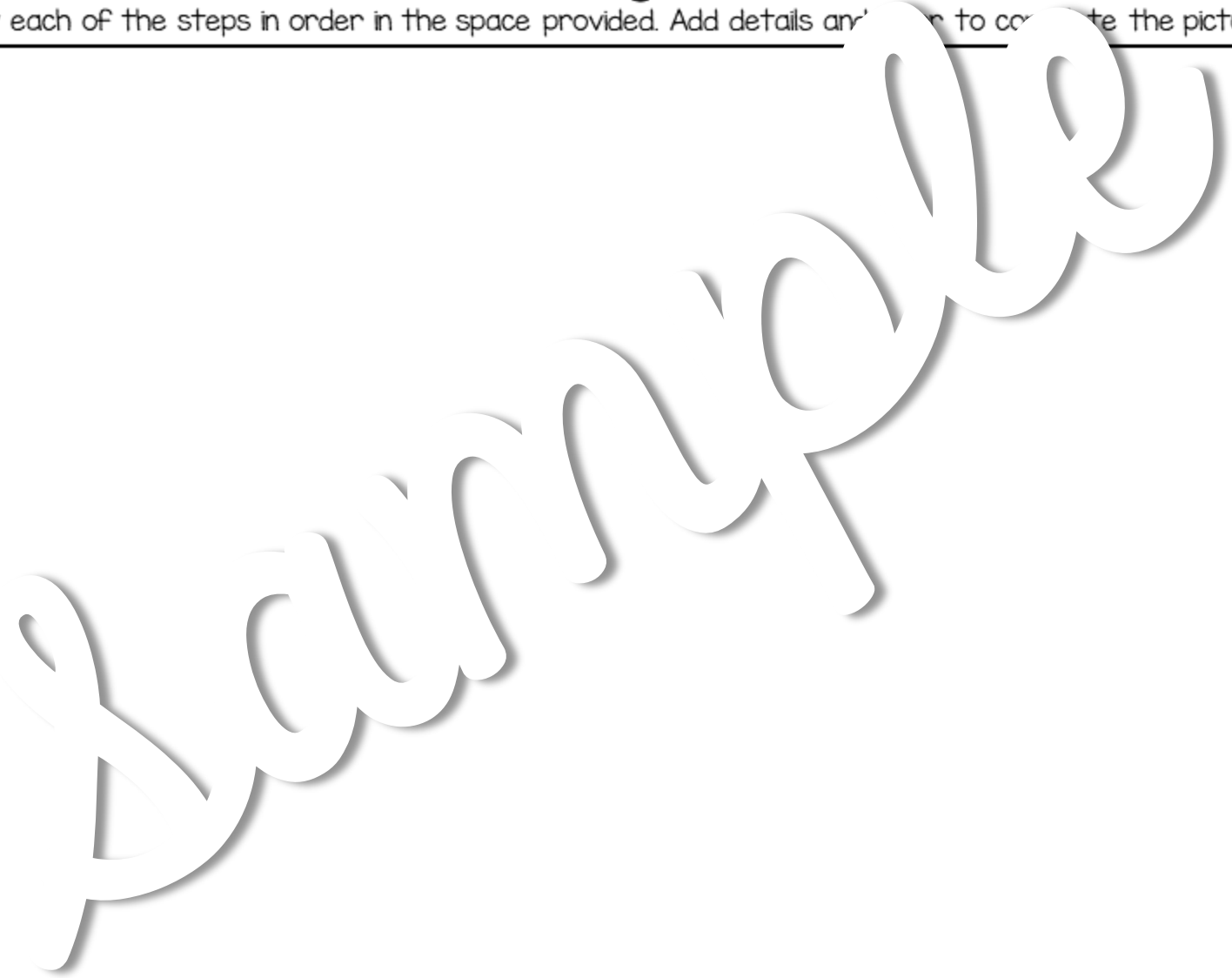
