
4 & 6-STEP DRAWINGS

Create a student drawing journal or portfolio with a collection of their best work and a cover.



READING ACTIVITIES




Basketball








Type I: Draw a picture in the space provided with the 5-step instructions. Cut and paste a strip at the top of the page.

Type 2: Pick and choose what to draw a picture of in the space provided with your choice of 5-step drawing.










Pick and Draw Activity Strips




