



Sentence Work


These worksheets provide two ways for kids to practice sentence structure: sentence building and sentence practice. For March, the focus is on contractions, adverbs, and adjectives.



Kids will love using their Spring Code Chart to crack the code for the mystery sight words. The recording sheet is provided at three levels to support all students!






Trigraph Spin & Color

Kids will spin the spinner and find a picture that matches the given trigraph. Great for literacy centers, word work, or small groups. Multiple versions make differentiation a breeze!

Around The Room Scoot

Get students out of their chairs and moving around the room as they search for picture cards and practice spelling words with different vowel teams. Differentiated recording sheets are provided!

R-Controlled Vowel Sort

Print, cut, and laminate these cards, then let students practice sorting by r-controlled vowel. Then, have them record their answers on the form.






Match The Plurals

Kids match singular words to their plural for this center. This could also be played as memory or Go Fish! After all pairs are made, students record their answers. Differentiated cards included.

Contraction Puzzles

Students piece together puzzles to build contractions. Once all puzzles are completed, they fill in the recording form with the words.

Affixes Clip Cards

Kids clip all the pictures that match the given affix. Once they are done clipping the cards, they record their answers on one of the differentiated recording sheets.






Build The CVCe Words

Conjunction Task Cards


These task cards are the perfect way to practice identifying and using conjunctions. Kids work through the cards and fill out their answers.



Decodable Reader

Kids practice decoding words with CVCe words, suffixes, r-controlled vowels and reading sight words in the decodable reader (3 levels included).

There are 3 versions provided for each level: one with black and white illustrations, one with color, and one with just text so students can add their own illustrations.


