



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May Worksheets

Sentence Work


These worksheets provide two ways for kids to practice sentence structure: sentence building and sentence practice. For May, the focus is on pronounce and punctuation.



Crack The Code

Kids will love using their Spring Code Chart to crack the code for the mystery words with vowel teams. The recording sheet is provided at three levels to support all students!





Sound Isolation Spin & Color

Print, cut, and laminate these cards, then let students practice sorting by fact or opinion. Then, have them record their answers on the form.






Match The Parts of Speech

Multisyllabic Word Puzzles


Students piece together puzzles to build words with multiple syllables. Once all puzzles are completed, they fill in the recording form with the words.

Diphthong Clip Cards

Kids clip all the sentences that match the given diphthong sound. Once they are done clipping the cards, they record their answers on one of the differentiated recording sheets.






Build The Diphthongs

Kids will love this hands-on building center where they trace, write, and build words with diphthongs. Building materials could include tiles, magnets, play doh, or any other classroom materials!

Sight Word Task Cards

These task cards are the perfect way to practice identifying, reading, and writing sight words. Kids work through the cards and fill out their answers.



Literacy Activities

Decodable Reader

Kids practice decoding words with CVCe words, vowel teams, r-controlled vowels and reading sight words in the decodable reader (3 levels included).

There are 3 versions provided for each level: one with black and white illustrations, one with color, and one with just text so students can add their own illustrations.



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Decodable Passages

These passages are a great way to assess reading fluency. After reading the story, students will complete a series of comprehension questions. Three levels of text are provided with two levels of comprehension questions for each text.




