**Directed Drawing - Scarecrow**

Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

**1.** Draw a U shape for the bottom of the head. Draw a curved line across the top and sides of the U to form the brim of the hat.

**2.** Draw a straight line coming out at each side under the head to form the top of each arm. Draw a line that goes inward and then out to form each side of the scarecrow's body.

**3.** Draw an upside down V shape in between each leg and connect with a straight line across. Connect the arms to the body on each side. Draw the top of the hat and add a straight line across the hat.

**6.** Draw hay under the head, and coming out of the arm holes and leg holes.

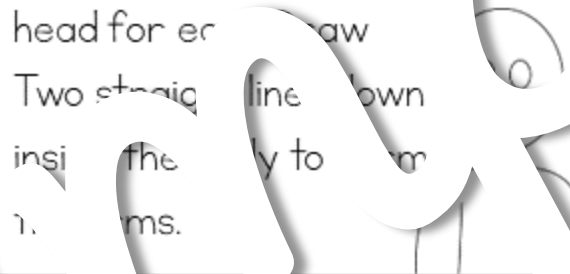
## Directed Drawing - Veteran

Follow the written directions and steps in order to draw a picture.

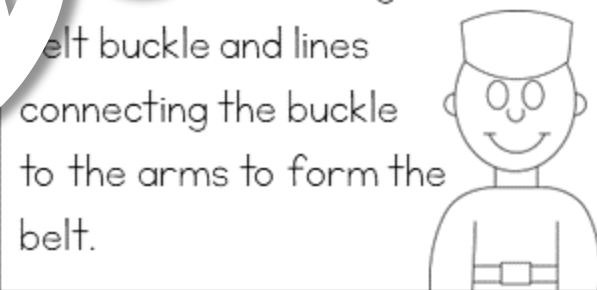
**1.** Draw an oval for the head. Draw two small lines down for the neck. Draw a curved line under the neck to form the shoulders and arms.



**2.** Draw two ovals for eyes inside the larger oval. Draw a curved line for a smile and a U shape for the nose. Add a curved line on both sides of the head for ears. Draw two straight lines down inside the head to form the hairline.



**3.** Draw a curved line across the forehead. Draw two lines up on each side and a curved line across the top to make the hat. Draw a small rectangle for the belt buckle and lines connecting the buckle to the arms to form the belt.



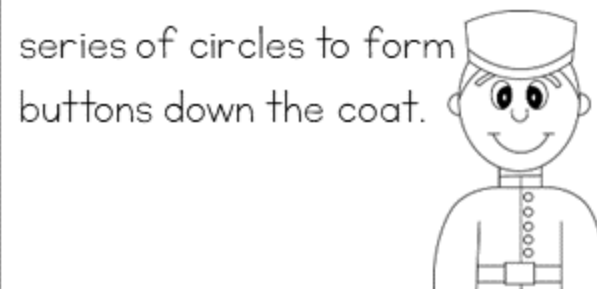
**4.** Draw a straight line across the neck. Draw a straight line down from the collar and a curved line behind the belt.



**5.** Draw a curved line inside the head for a smile. Draw a curved line from the neck to above each ear for the hairline.



**6.** Color in an oval in each eye leaving a small white space. Draw two eyebrow shapes coming from under the hat. Draw a series of circles to form buttons down the coat.
