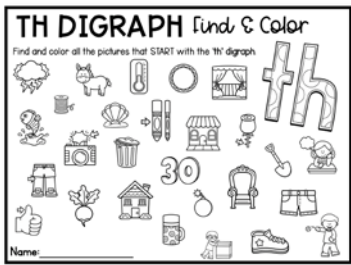
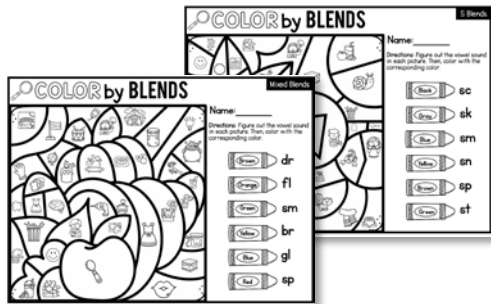

## Sentence Work

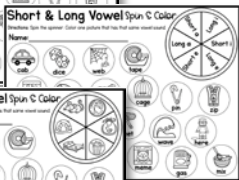
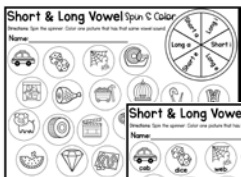
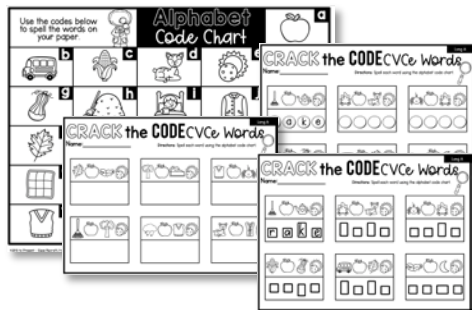
These worksheets provide two ways for kids to practice sentence structure: sentence building and sentence practice. For November, the focus is on the capitalization and different kinds of ending punctuation.

Kids will love using their Fall Code Chart to crack the code for the mystery CVCe words. The recording sheet is provided at three levels to support all students!

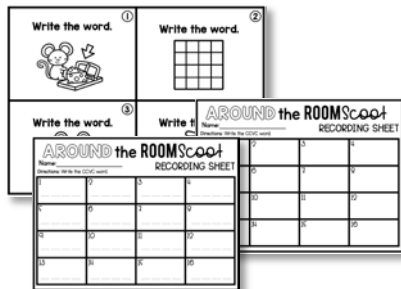


## Short/Long Vowel Spin & Color

Get students out of their chairs and moving around the room as they search for picture cards and practice spelling CCVC words. Differentiated recording sheets are provided!



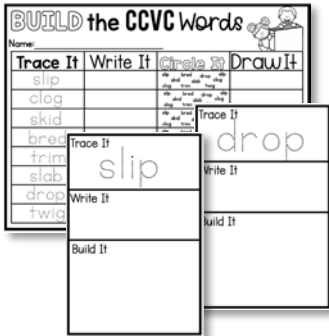
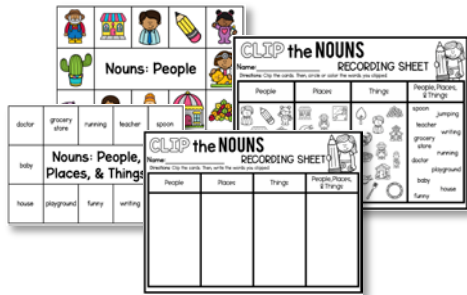




# November Centers

## Noun Clip Cards

Kids can clip all the pictures in the given noun category: people, places, things, or all nouns. Once they are done clipping the cards, they can record their answers.

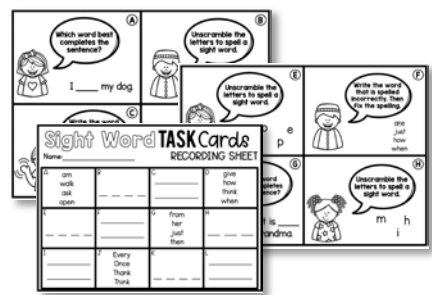


## Build The CCVC Words

These task cards are the perfect way to practice prepositions. Kids will work through the cards and fill out their answers on the recording sheet.

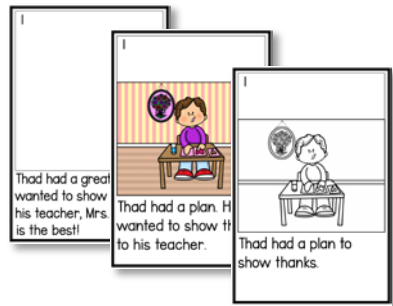

# Literacy Activities

## Decodable Reader

Kids can practice decoding CCVC words, words with the TH digraph, and reading sight words in the decodable reader (3 levels included). There are 3 versions provided for each: one with black and white illustrations, one with color, and one with just text so students can add their own illustrations.



## Decodable Passages

These passages are a great way to assess reading fluency. After reading the story, students will complete a series of comprehension questions. Three levels of text are provided with two levels of comprehension questions for each text.

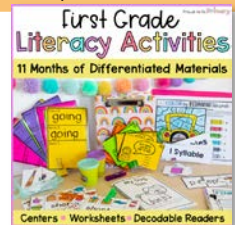
