






## **Poetry Activities**

## Math Activities

## Science and STEAM

This resource includes a St. Patrick's Day *Over Top of the Rainbow* STEAM activity and *Walking Water* science experiment. Discuss making a hypothesis and see what happens when you mix colors in water. Make rainbows out of pipe cleaners and playdough, and test their strength with a cup of coins with the STEAM activity this St. Patrick's Day.








## Leprechaun Directed Drawing
