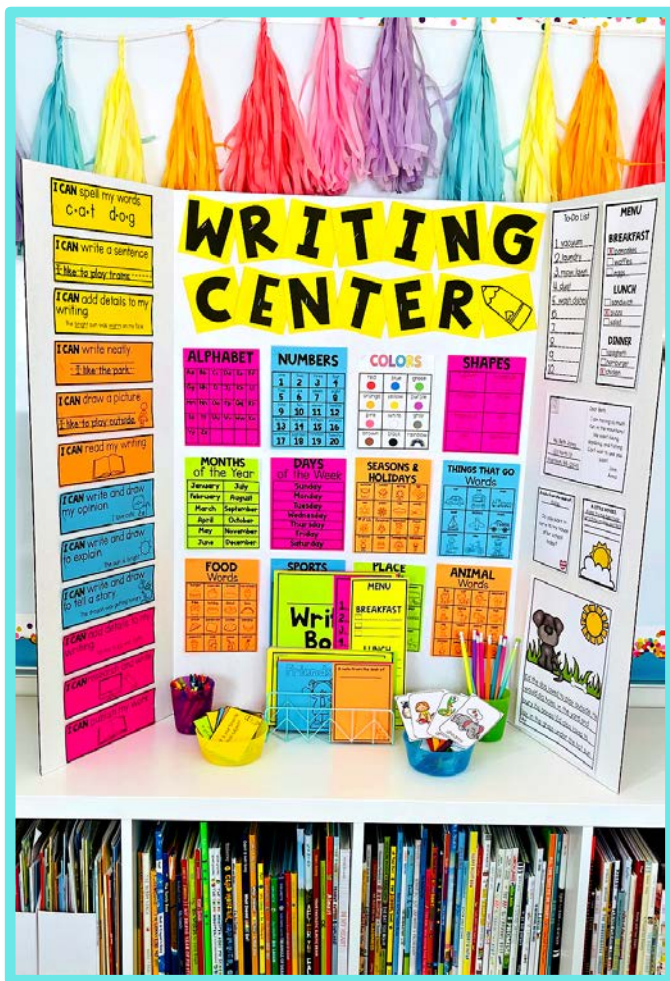

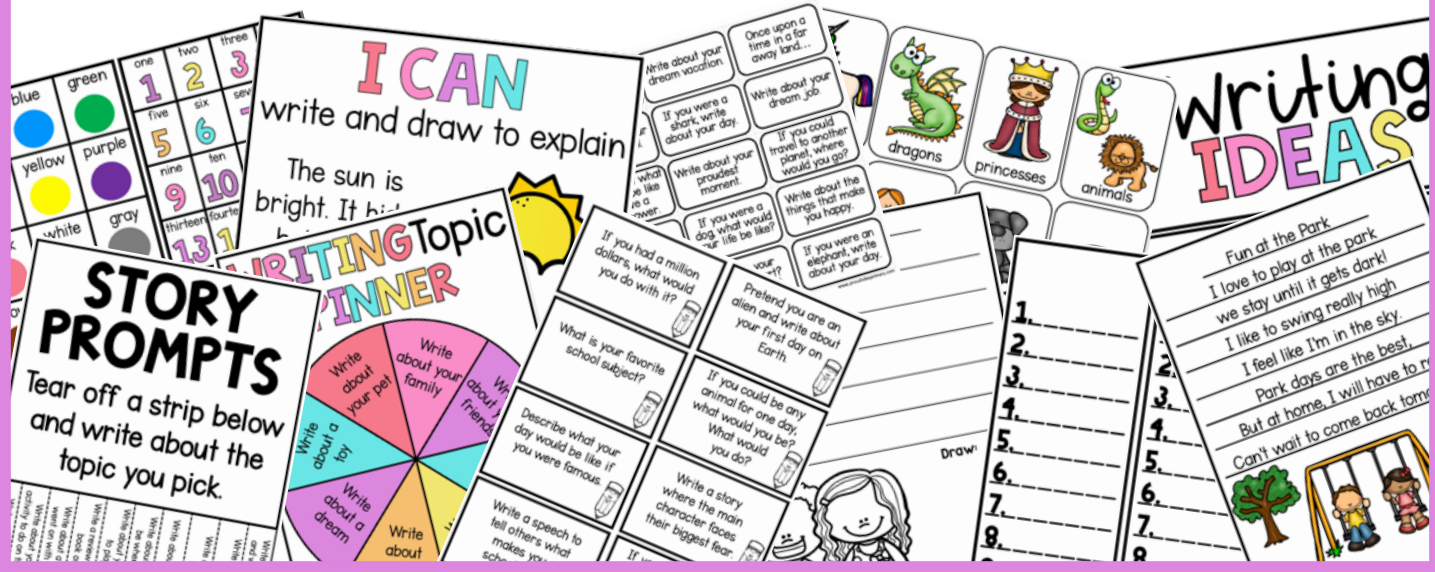

- ✓ Print the writing activities for your students to practice writing in a fun way with a partner or independently.



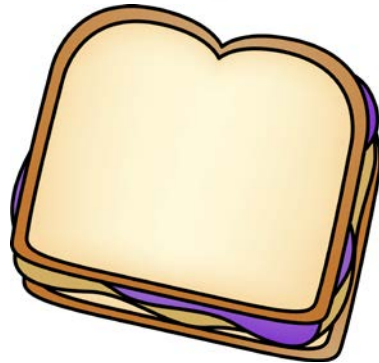
Recipe for: Peanut Butter & Jelly Sandwich

Peanut Butter

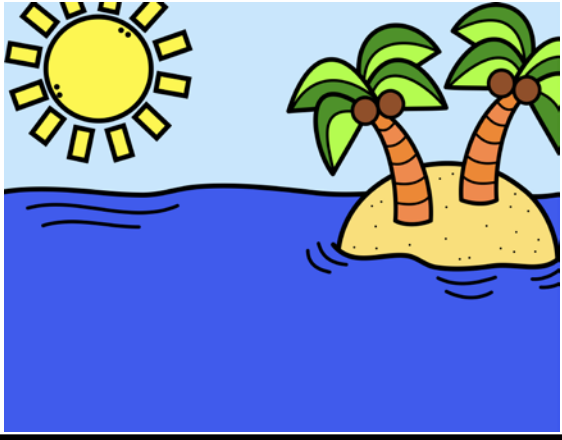
Jelly

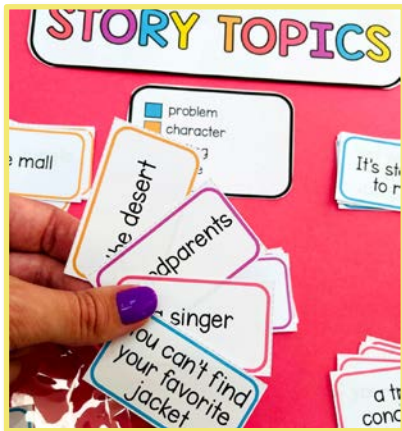

All In One WRITING Center

How to Set-Up Your Writing Center

- ✓ Create a writing center in your classroom as either a permanent place or in a pop-up style on a trifold or something moveable.
- ✓ Let your students know that all the writing items will be located in this area for easy access.
- ✓ Hang up the posters to allow your students to use the words to help enhance their writing and learn how to become stronger writers.
- ✓ Have a place to put the writing templates for easy access. Decide if you'd like to have them all out or a few at a time to allow for students to choose what they'd like to write.
- ✓ Writing spinners, bingo, and tear strips can be used occasionally or as an additional way to allow for students to choose a form of writing.
- ✓ Encourage independence in the writing center to allow for creativity and confidence.

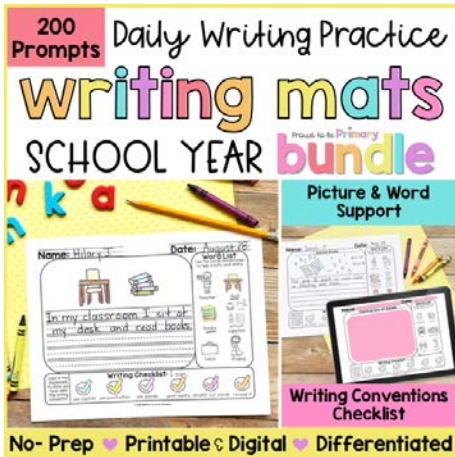
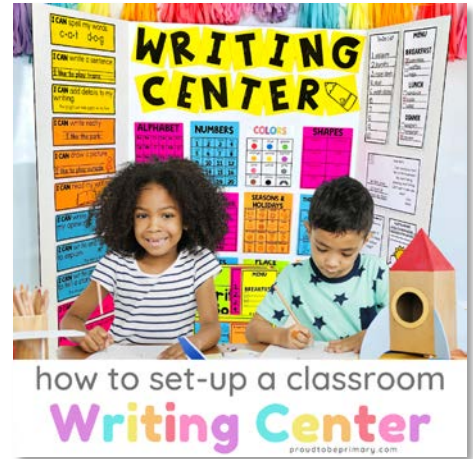
