Clay Words

Create your own clay sight words and extras to practice word families, forming sentences and other literacy activities.

Gather:

- Air dry clay
- Pottery knife (or similar)
- Clay carving tools
- Gem gravel
- Paint
- Water
- · Baking paper
- Rolling pin



Create:

- 1. Make a list of the words you could like to make.
- 2. Roll out your clay and cut them into even rows. Separate your rows.
- 3. Using your tools, scribe the letters for your words onto the clay and then carve them deeper into the clay.
- 4. Use a little water on your fingertip to carefully smooth out your clay.
- 5. Gently place a few crystals around each word and press them into the clay with the flat back of one of your carving tools.
- 6. Cut your separate words apart and set aside to dry.
- 7. Once your words have dried, you may choose to paint inside the carved letters to make them stand out more. Let the paint dry and you're all done!





Note: Paint some wood slices with pictures to match words as an extension to your set.
