## Teaching tips

Most students will be able to name some of the resources used for each item listed, and with help in the thinking process, take the items back to their origins. For example – the hamburger involves a bun, made from wheat, grown in the soil, using water, fertilisers, etc and transported by truck and ship, meat from cattle, etc, the phone includes metal minerals taken from the soil, plastic made from petroleum oil by-products, and so on.

They all involve the use of energy, water and human resources.

To try to find all the resources used in each item will take some persistence but some students may be willing to research one or more items more thoroughly. Results for deeper level research can be presented in the form of a flow chart.
