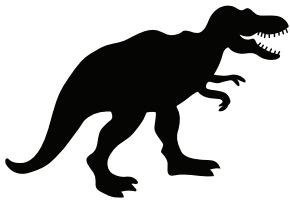

The second dinosaur boasted, "I am the strongest. I can shake the tree and help him!"

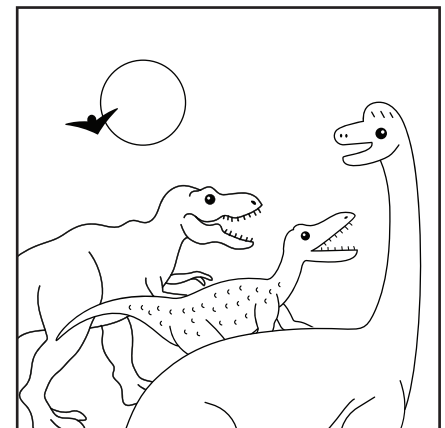
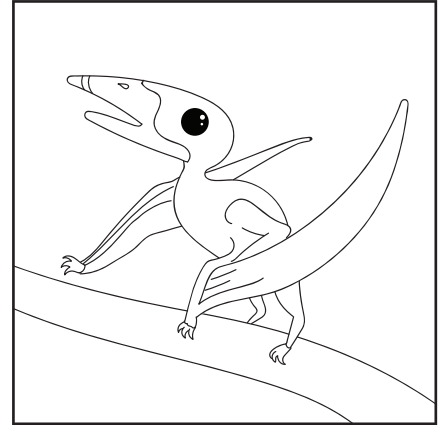
The third dinosaur cried, "I can jump! I can help him!"
