Care & Maintenance

Wool is naturally self-cleansing and dirt repellent. Cleaning is rarely needed. If the blanket acquires a stain, it is recommended to clean the stain, not the whole blanket.

Handle with care. Repeated washing will have a negative effect on the quality.

Avoid friction between the fibers when wet, as this can cause unwanted felting and shrinkage.

Cleaning Instructions

We recommend dry cleaning or wool program (maximum 30 degrees Celsius / 86 degrees Fahrenheit), using a proper detergent (for wool).

Do Not Tumble Dry – Do not Use Heat

When wet, leave the blanket flat with a towel or towels folded neatly around it.
