The serious stuff:

Sourced from 10 year old Sangiovese vines in the deep south of Margaret River, hand harvested, de-stemmed and crushed into top concrete fermenters and left on skins for 7 days.

Raised in French oak barriques for 18 months; 10% new and 90% seasoned oak.

Harvest March 2018

Maturation: 18 months in oak Bottled: November 2020

Alcohol: 14.0% vol

pH: 3.62 TA: 4.94 g/L RS: 0.68 g/L

But, what does it taste like?

Bright and energetic with soft, pure aromatics and a whiff of dusty oak. Cherry cola and strawberry gentle tomato leaf tannins and bright acidity to polish off.
