

## The serious stuff:

60 % Frankland River Pinot Noir and 40 % Shiraz from 20 – 25 year old vines, hand harvested, de-stemmed, co-fermented and crushed into open top concrete fermenters and left on skins for 8 days. Raised in French oak barriques for 8 months – 20% new, 80% seasoned oak

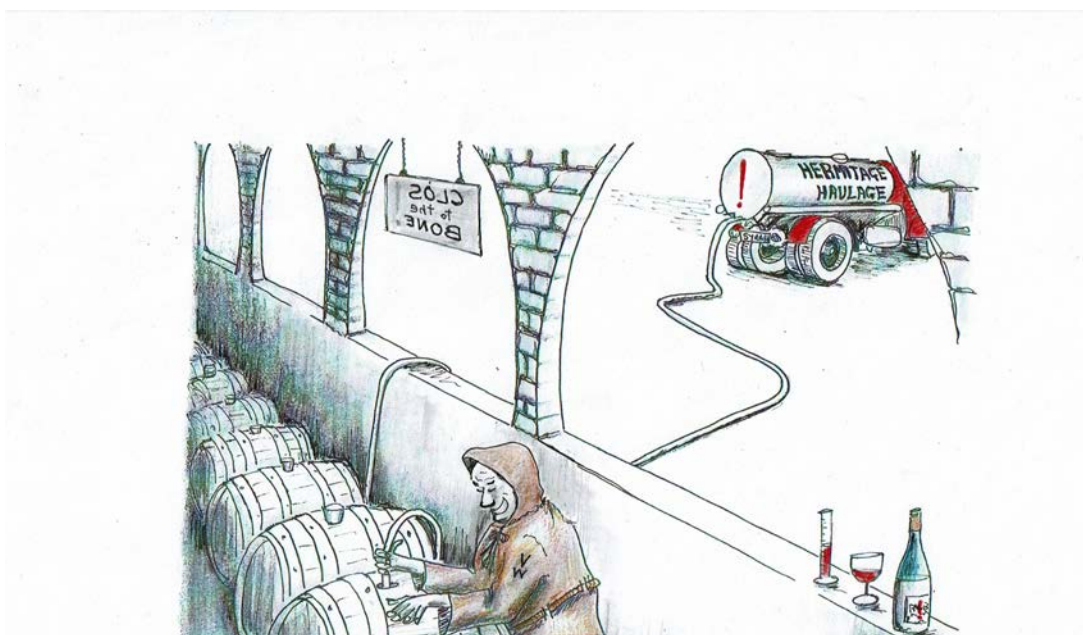


## But, what does it taste like?
