Check that you received all the parts listed on the parts list, if you have any concerns, please contact PerTronix before continuing. Headers will have the part number stamped in the flange.

Work Smart – Work Safe! Most Header and Exhaust Installation are best performed on a lift. If a lift is not available, raise the vehicle and support on quality Jack Stands on level ground. Do not rely on a jack!

Start:

- Remove and inventorynew JBA exhaust system.
- Disconnect negative battery cable and allow vehicle to cool.
- Remove the nutsattaching the factory tail pipe to the exhaust system.



Remove the factory tail pipe.



Remove the nutsattaching the exhaust system to the catalytic converters.



Unbolt and remove the center mounted exhaust hanger.



Remove the muffler and Yassembly from the truck.





 Fit the center exhaust hanger rubber grommet on to the hanger attached to the Y-pipe assembly (B). Then reattach it to the frame.





 Slide the cross over tube (A) into the Y-pipe assembly (B) with the bend facing the front of the vehicle.

 Then fit the Cross over (A) into the Y-pipe (B) and then connect it to the factory catalytic converter.



 Install the 2-1/2" clamps (H) over the slip connections on the resonators assembly.



 Install the JBA intermediate pipe (C) on to the resonator assembly and fit 3" clamp (I) over slip connection.





 Install the 3" clamp with hanger (I) in to the rear muffler hanger grommet.



 Install the JBA muffler (D) on to the intermediate pipe (C) with the logo facing the rear of the vehicle.



 Secure the muffler in place with the 3" clamp with hanger (I) at the rear and a 3" clamp (H) at the front of the muffler.



Secure the resonator/crossover assembly.



 Install the tail pipe (E) in to the rear of the muffler (D).

 Install the turn out with tip and hanger (F) in to the end of the tail pipe (E). Insert the hanger in to the rear most exhaust hanger grommet.



 Align the turn out (F) for clearance around spare tire and rear axle.

 Check for adequate clearance for the chrome tip from paint and body. With the turn out (F) properly aligned, secure it in place by tightening the 3" clamp (H).

21. Using a soft cloth, remove all prints from the exhaust tip.

22. Check all clamps and connections for proper fit and alignment. Double check all clamps are tightened and that all hangers are secure in rubber grommets. It is recommended that after installation of this system you have all slip connections tack welded by a muffler shop.

NOTES:

 It may be necessary to loosen and realign the spare tire for proper clearance.

 All exhaust systems expand about 1" rearward when exhaust temperature rises.

Use anti-seize on threads of clamps.

If there is no retailer in your area, call the factory for a return authorization and return your part prepaid to the factory for inspection. PerTronix reserves the rights to replace or repair the alleged defective part and return the part freight collect.
