- Installation of the module can be done with the distributor on the car, or the distributor removed. It is easier to access components if you remove the distributor from the engine.
- 2. Check the base timing, and record that value.
- Disconnect the battery negative terminal. Then disconnect power and tach from HEI distributor.
- 4. Disconnect the 3 wire plug between the distributor and cap.
- 5. Remove distributor cap and rotor.
- Remove mounting screws retaining HEI module. Lift module up, and disconnect the connectors at both ends. Remove HEI module, and wipe the distributor clean.
- Apply a light layer of the included heat sink compound to the bottom of the HEI module. Connect HEI module to both connectors, and insert into distributor. The 2 plastic pins on the bottom of the module should fit into the holes on the distributor.
- Re-install mounting screws on the HEI module and make sure they are tight. NOTE: The module is grounded through these, so these MUST be installed for the HEI to work correctly.
- WARNING Ensure that the factory HEI noise filter capacitor inside of the distributor is intact and correctly mounted. Failure to do so could result in damage to the module. If your capacitor is damaged, you can purchase a replacement harness (PN #D9007).

- 11. Connect the distributor harness, power, and optional tach wires to the distributor cap.
- 12. Reconnect the negative battery cable.
