# STEP 1 - Choose your spex (We include dimensions and photos of the spex from all angles)





STEP 2 - SELECT THE PRESCRIPTION TYPE FROM THE DROP DOWN MENU

Prescription distance


This is the prescription the majority of us will be using for our spex. It includes both + and - prescriptions.

Prescription reading

This is specific to those who have a distance prescription but also have an additional reading prescription. This will be marked on the prescription under the section 'ADD' or Reading Addition.

### STEP 3 - UPLOAD YOUR PRESCRIPTION

To keep things as simple as possible - you can send us a photo of your prescription (like the one below). This ensures no details are missed.

Do you want your spex to be sunglasses?

Then you need to choose a tint or

Do you need spex that will transition with the light? If you do, you can choose from 2 tint options.
