

Penguin Party Sweaters

a quilt pattern supplement by Elizabeth Hartman

Use this simple modification to make sweaters with sleeves for your Penguin Party blocks! As in the original pattern, you will use the same process, with some different-sized pieces to make the Short (S), Medium (M), or Tall (T) Penguin Blocks.

Cutting the Fabric

Cut the fabric as described in the pattern, making the following modifications:

Black Penguin Fabric

- For all block variation (S, M, or T) adjust the size of pieces F to 1-1/2" x 1-3/4". (These will be the ends of the arms/wings.)
- For all block variation (S, M, or T) cut one piece K2, 2-1/4" x 7-1/2". (This will be the bottom of the penguin body.)

Penguin Body Fabric

In this modification, the Penguin Body Fabric is the sweater fabric. Adjust the size of piece K (sweater body) and cut 2 pieces F2 (sweater arms).

- For each Short Penguin, cut 1 piece K, 5-3/4" tall x 7-1/2" wide, and 2 pieces F2, each 1-1/2" wide x 4" tall.
- For each Medium Penguin, cut 1 piece K, 6-3/4" tall x 7-1/2" wide, and 2 pieces F2, each 1-1/2" wide x 5" tall.
- For each Tall Penguin, cut 1 piece K, 7-1/2" wide x 7-3/4" tall, and 2 pieces F2, each 1-1/2" wide x 6" tall.

Making the Blocks

Follow these directions to make each block:

Complete Steps 1 - 13 as described in the pattern. Before continuing to Step 14, sew together pieces F and F2 to make 2 identical pieced units like the one shown in **Fig. 1**. Then, sew together pieces K and K2 to make a pieced unit like the one shown in **Fig. 2**. Once you've done this, continue following the pattern to complete Steps 14 - 16.







