



Follow the instructions on "disconnecting your v-brakes"

Squeeze the brake lever to expose the cable head. Remove the cable head from the slot in the lever and remove entire brake cable from the lever.







Ensure the barrel adjust is rotated so that the slot in the barrel adjust is aligned with the slot in the lever.

Repeat step 3 on the other brake lever. Once removed, swap the brake cables around to change which lever controls which brake.

If parts such as bolts and nuts become loose or damaged, the bicycle may suddenly fall over, which may cause serious injury.


In addition, if adjustments are not carried out correctly, problems may occur, and the bicycle may suddenly fall over, which may cause serious injury.

After reading the manual thoroughly, keep it in a safe place for later reference.


Make sure only to use the correct tools specified in this user manual.

# **SWAPPING BRAKE CABLES**






Re install the cable end into the slot in the brake lever and let the brake spring back to position.






Follow the "connecting your v-brake" instructions to reconnect your brake.



Rotate the locknut to ensure the security of the cable.
