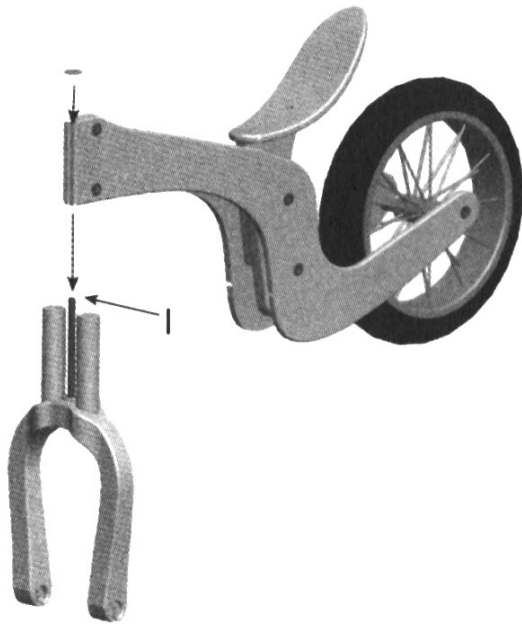

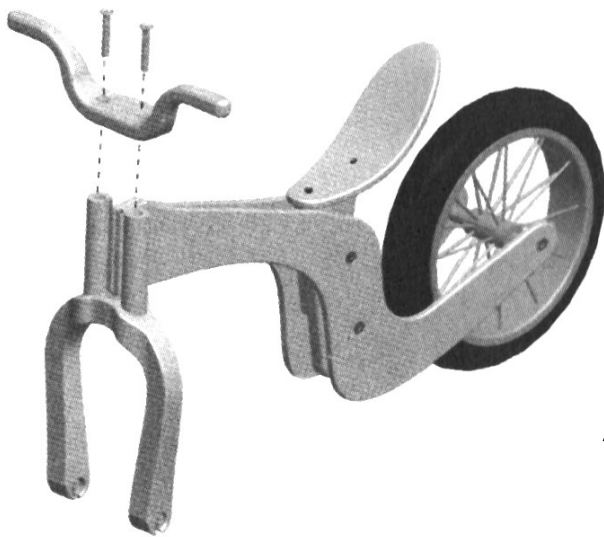

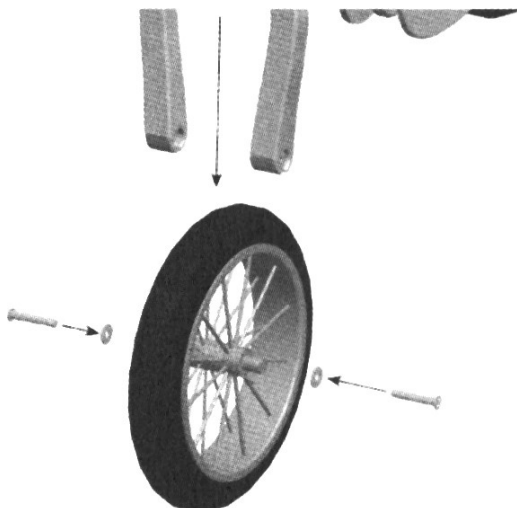
STEP 1 : PLACE STEERING AXLE(1) INTO FRONT HOLE ON WOODEN FORK TO COMPLETE FORK ASSEMBLY UNIT (C)

STEP 2: SLIDE BODY ASSEMBLY (D) ONTO STEERING AXLE(I) ON FPRK ASSEMBLY (C)

• *NOTE:THE FORK ASSEMBLY 9C) SHOULD BE FLAT SIDE FACING FORWARD AS SHOWN*



STEP 3: SECURE HANDLEBARS(A) TO FORK ASSEMBLY (C) USING THE 41MM BOLTS (H)

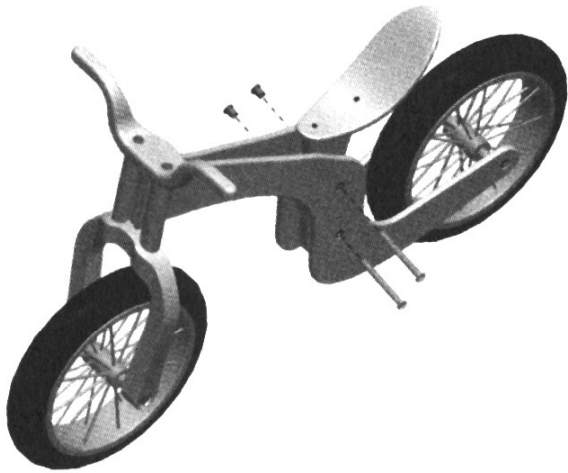


STEP 4: AFFIX FRONT WHEEL (E) BY FIRST LOOSELY INSERTING 37MM CONNECTOR BOLTS (B) INTO THE 2 SMALL WASHER (G) THEN INTO EACH SIDE OF THE WHEEL'S HUB

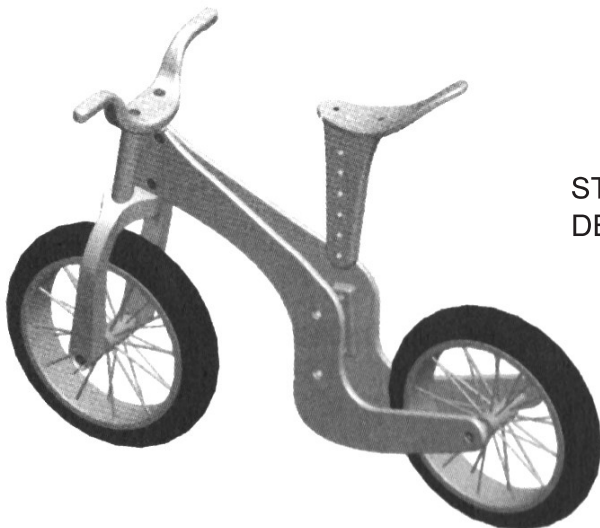
• *NOTE: THE 37MM BOLTS SHOULD ONLY TRAVEL 2-3MM INSIDE THE HUB AT THIS TIME*

STEP 5: SLIDE FORK ASSEMBLY (C) ONTO THE 37MM CONNECTOR BOLTS (B) SITTING ON EACH SIDE OF THE WHEEL (E). ONCE FORK ASSEMBLY IS IN PLACE, TIGHTEN THE 37MM CONNECTOR BOLTS (B) SIMULTANEOUSLY USING BOTH ALLEN KEYS

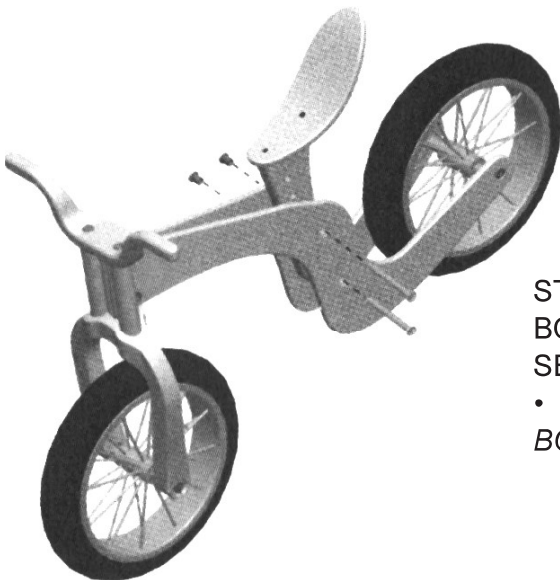
ADJUSTING SEAT HEIGHT



STEP 1: REMOVE THE 2 CONNECTOR BOLTS & CORRESPONDING SLEEVE NUTS FROM THE MAIN BODY AS SHOWN.



STEP 2: LIFT SEAT POST & REPOSITION AT DESIRED HEIGHT



STEP 3: ALIGN HOLES IN SEAT POST WITH HOLES IN BODY PANELS. RE-INSERT CONNECTOR BOLTS & SECURE WITH SLEEVE NUTS AS SHOWN.

• *TIP: DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN THE BOLTS UNTIL BOTH BOLTS ARE LOCATED.*

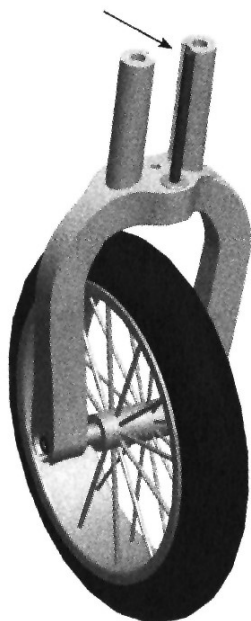

STEP 1: REMOVE THE 41MM BOLTS (H), & REMOVE THE HANDLEBARS(A)

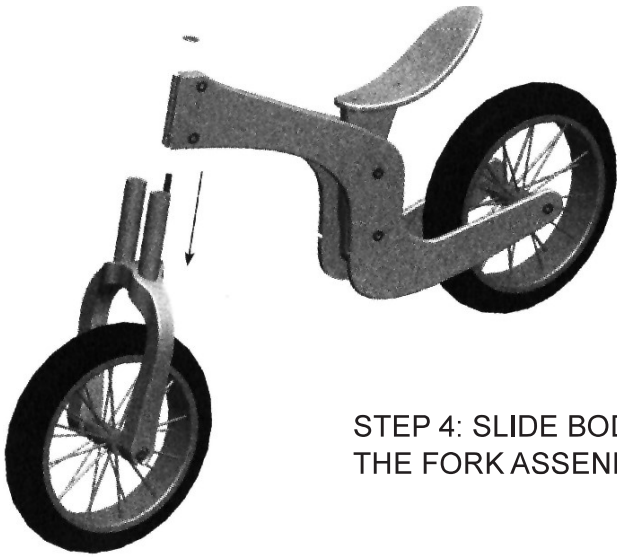


STEP 2: SLIDE BODY ASSEMBLY (D) UPWARDS TO REMOVE FROM AXLE (I)

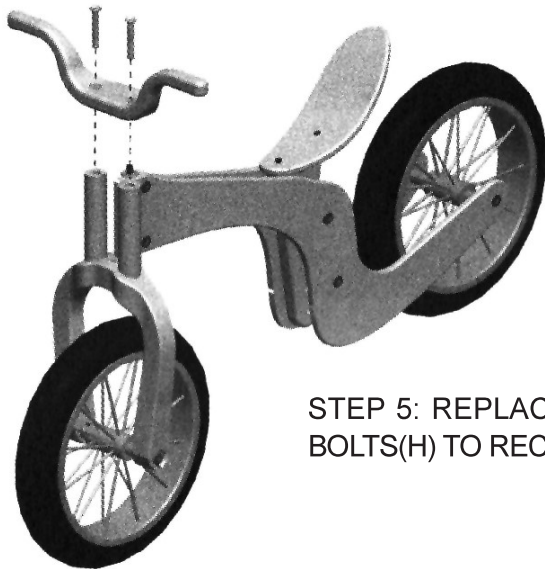

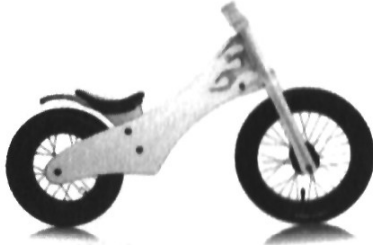
MAINTENANCE & CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- YOUR EARLY RIDER IS FITTED WITH PILL BOTTLE SAFETY VALVE CAPS. TO REMOVE, PRESS DOWN & TURN IN ANTI-CLOCKWISE DIRECTION
- NEVER LEAVE YOUR EARLY RIDER OUTSIDE FOR PROLONGED PERIODS OF TIME
- AFTER RIDING, WIPE AWAY ANY WATER OR MUD WITH CLEAN CLOTH

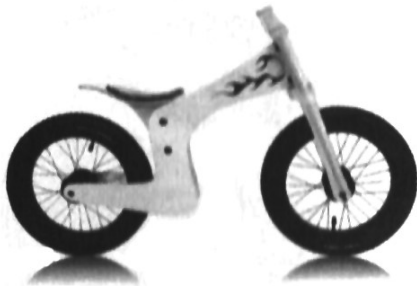
